Tells How They're Made

"The soup has a history going back to the battlefield of Arny-le-duc, where Henry IV distinguished himself in 1569," he explained. "It was first made by King Henry's soldiers on the battlefield, under his instructions. Simple, it is made from capon flesh and is flavored with rice and tomatoes."

"The sole was one of Cardinal Richelieu's favorite dishes. The 60 lbs. of sole, after being buttered, are braised in white wine for about 12 minutes over a slow fire, with pepper and salt. A sauce is made of fish stock, white wine and butter, boiled to the consistency of syrup, and it should be poured through a muslin before use. An additional garniture of green marenne oysters completes the delicacy."

New Turkey Trimmings

Lady's attention was called to the Turkey which he had included on the menu.

"Ah," said Lady, "that, alas, is a concession to those conservatives who would insist on its presence. But it is made according to an old recipe originated in 1573 when Turkey became an English dish. In those days it was stuffed with sausage meat and breadcrumbs and it is still the best way to serve turkey."

"Catherine de Medici's favorite sweet is made similar to our Christmas pudding, with all kinds of fruits, highly spiced and boiled to a dark rich mixture. Catherine made it peculiarly her own by covering the whole with almond paste, laying the mixture in the paste like a tart."

Only Eight Nobel Peace Prize Winners Are Living

son, Sweden, and F. Bajer, Denmark, 1908; A. M. F. Beernaert, Belgium, and Baron de Constant, France, 1909; T. M. C. Asser, Denmark, and A. H. Fried, Austria, 1911; Woodrow Wilson, 1918; L. Bourgeois, France, 1920; H. K. Branting, Sweden, 1921. The first awards were distributed on the fifth anniversary of Nobel's death, December 10, 1901.

The prize was given to the Institute of International Law in 1904, the International Peace Bureau in 1910 and the International Red Cross in 1917. No awards were made in other years.

When first distributed in 1901, the value of the prize was \$10,000, but it was decreased under taxation.

For this year it is \$31,250 and for last year \$31,976.

A bill passed by the Swedish parliament removes the taxation after this year.

JIMMY MALONEY WINS HIS THIRD ELIMINATION GO

NEW YORK, Dec. 23. — Jimmy Maloney won the third consecutive fight in Tex Rickard's heavyweight elimination tournament, when he won the decision over Harry Persson, of Sweden. The bell saved Persson from a knockout.

Monte Muuss' long winning streak ended when Knute Hansen received the decision in a 10 round semi-final.
