WASHINGTON, Fob. 26 .- Presented with several scores of telegrams sent to Washington to Publisher E. M. McLean from Fall at Palm Beach were given the Senate Oil Committee which went into executive session.

The telegrams contained several hundred words and were presented by Division Superintendents of the Postal and Western Union.

After a two hours conference, the committee adjourned until tomorrow stating examination of the telegrams had not been completed. Chairman Lenroot stated some of the telegrams will be placed in the

Declares in Letter to Senator Willis He Will Help Oil Committee.
