

JERRY SIMPSON DEAD

Kansas Politician Passes Away of General Breakdown.

Wichita, Kansas, Oct. 25—Ex-Congressman Jerry Simpson died Monday of general breakdown. He had been ill for some time.

Mr. Simpson had been one of the Populist leaders of Kansas since 1890 in which year he was first elected to Congress. He sprang at once into prominence because of the campaign story that he wore no socks, and for a long time he was known as "Sockless Jerry." He was re-elected to Congress in 1892 and 1896. He achieved some prominence in the House of debater, although prior to his election to Congress he was a small farmer near Medicine Lodge, and wholly without political experience. Since his last defeat he had lived quietly in this city most of the time.

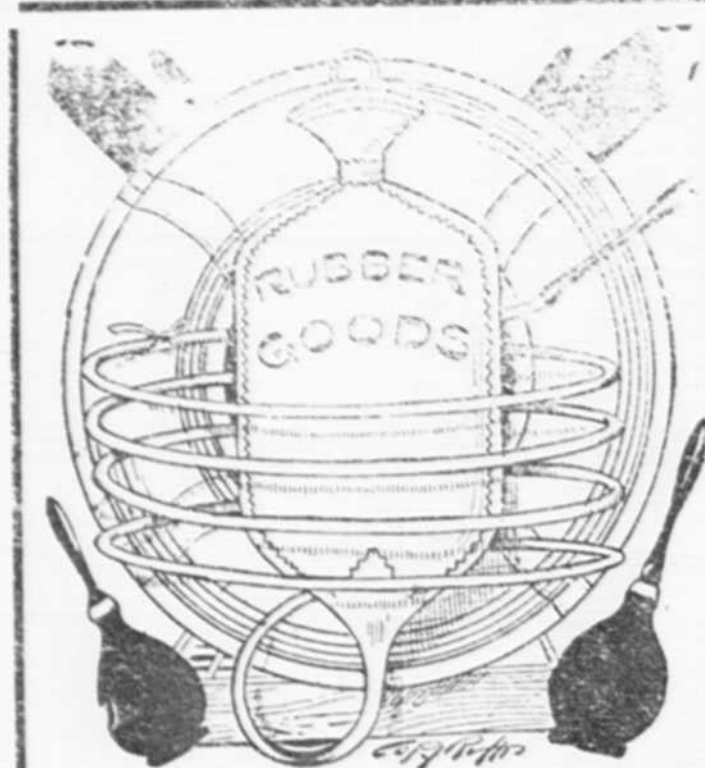

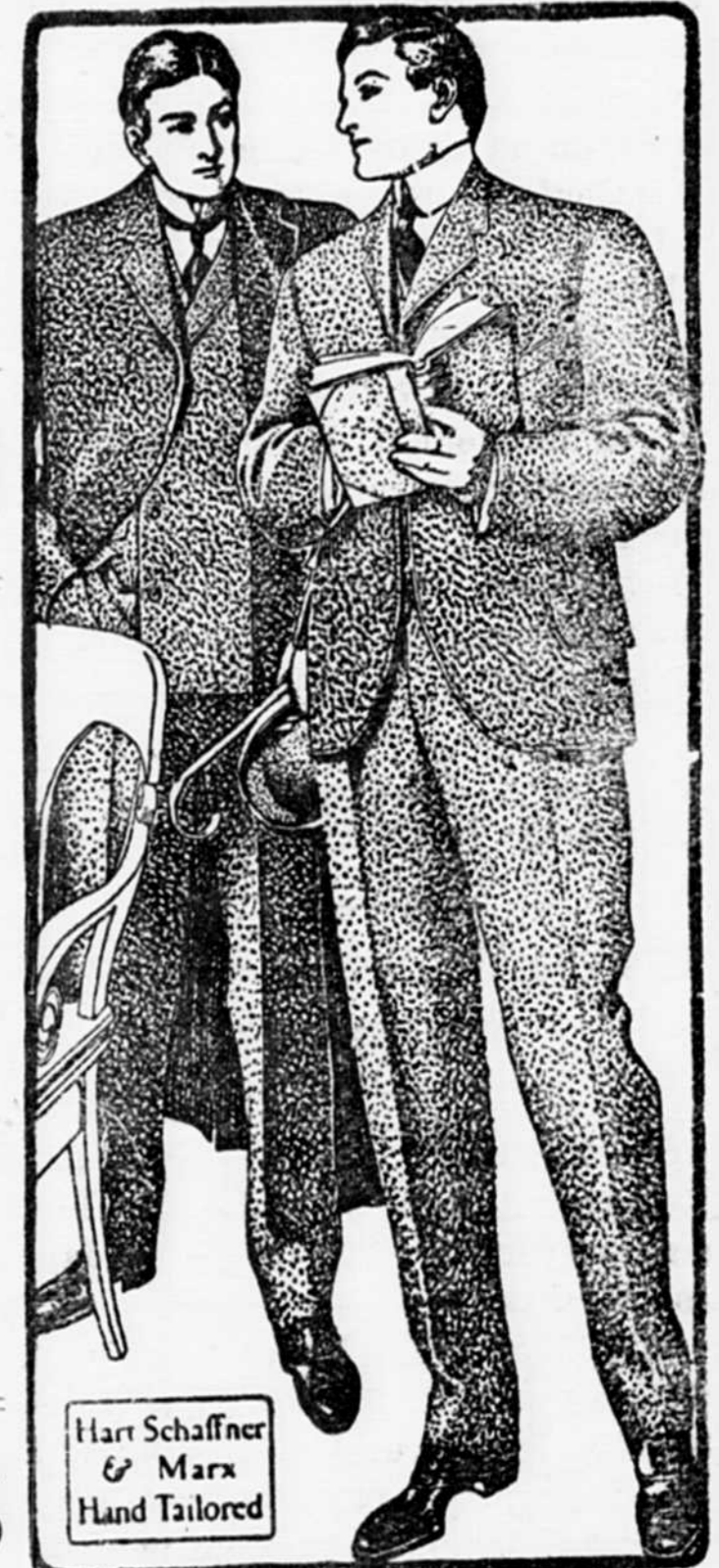
