ACT NO. 532.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to provide for a stenographer-clerk in the office of the insurance commissioner.

Authorizes the Insurance Commissioner to employ an additional stenographer-clerk at a salary of \$1,800.00 per year. Appropriates the sum of \$1,200.00 to supplement the appropriation made for the maintenance of the department to pay the additional salary.

ACT NO. 533.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to appropriate money for the promotion of veterinary work in the State of Arkansas.

Appropriates the sum of \$25,000.00 for salary and expenses of the State Veterinarian and assistants for the biennial period ending June 30, 1923.

ACT NO. 534.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to provide for the filing of delinquent lists of lands and town lots in road and drainage districts for the collection of delinquent taxes.

Provides that if the assessments against lands for improvement district taxes are not paid by the 10th of April the same become delinquent and the collector shall, on the second Monday in June, make out and file with the Chancery Court clerk a list of said property, containing the name of the supposed owner. Directs the clerk of said Chancery Court to issue a notice showing that said lands are delinquent for such taxes. Authorizes such persons to redeem such lands on the payment of taxes, penalty and interest. The said chancery clerk shall require the commissioners of the district in filing suit for the collection of such taxes to attach to their complaint a certified copy of the list and notice prepared and published by the clerk.

ACT NO. 535.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to regulate the registration of soldier, sailor and other non-resident pharmacists and assistant pharmacists.

Authorizes the Board of Pharmacists to register without examination any pharmacist or assistant pharmacist registered in any other state, territory or the District of Columbia, where such other state, territory or the District of Columbia grants such reciprocal rights to pharmacists from this State.

Directs the State Board of Pharmacy to issue bulletins from time to time informing the pharmacists of important United States Public Health regulations; service and regulatory announcements of the Bureau of Chemistry in the Department of Agriculture and decisions of the United States Treasury Department relating to the possession, use and sale of non-beverage U. S. P. alcohol and the Harrison-Wright Anti-Narcotic Act.

ACT NO. 536.

Approved March 21, 1921.
An Act to make appropriations for the maintenance and support of the University of Arkansas.

Appropriates for salaries for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1922, \$272,900.00.

For salaries for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1923, \$286,200.00.

Appropriates for maintenance, equipment, labor and all other expenses incident to the maintenance, operation and improvement of the University for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1922, \$152,604.77.

Appropriates for said purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1923, the sum of \$122,555.00.

Provides that should the appropriation contained in any item be found unnecessary for the purposes mentioned, the balance may be expended for any other purpose mentioned in the Act. Appropriates the sum of \$1,440.00, interest on J. S. Orphan notes, \$12,366.68 to pay the interest due on the Endowment Bonds for 1921 and 1922.

Authorizes the Board of Trustees to let all necessary contracts for printing and binding, etc.

ACT NO. 537.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to provide for the support and maintenance of the Arkansas Confederate Home.

Appropriates the sum of \$94,730.00 for salaries and current expenses, including clothing of residents, poll taxes, labor and other necessary expenses for the period ending June 30, 1922. Appropriates the sum of \$94,730.00 for salaries, current expenses, including clothing of residents, poll taxes, labor and other necessary expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1923.

ACT NO. 539.

Approved March 23, 1921.
An Act to provide for the support and maintenance of the Arkansas Deaf Mute Institute for the period ending June 30, 1923.

Appropriates the sum of \$100,428.00 for salaries, current expenses, including clothing, traveling expenses of pupils, \$100.00 per annum for each college student, repairs to buildings, maintenance of grounds and other necessary expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1922.

ACT NO. 538.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to provide for the support and maintenance of the Arkansas Hospital for Nervous Diseases for the biennial period beginning July 1, 1921, and ending June 30, 1923.

Appropriates the sum of \$413,050.00 for salaries and necessary expenses of the State Hospital for Nervous Diseases for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1922.

Appropriates the sum of \$413,050.00 for salaries and necessary expenses for the maintenance of the State Hospital for Nervous Diseases for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1923.

ACT NO. 540.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to provide for the support and maintenance of the Arkansas School for the Blind for the period beginning July 1, 1921, and ending June 30, 1923.

Appropriates the sum of \$54,852.00 for salaries and current expenses, supplies, equipment and other things necessary for the operation of the School for the Blind for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1922.

Appropriates the sum of \$51,852.00 for salaries, current expenses, supplies, and all necessary things for the operation of the School for the Blind for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1923.

ACT NO. 541.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to make appropriations for support and maintenance of the Arkansas Railroad Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 1923.

Appropriates the sum of \$27,600.00 for salaries, special services for clerks, stenographers and other employees and for current expenses, equipment and all necessary expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1922.

Appropriates the sum of \$29,100.00 for salaries and all necessary expenses for the Arkansas Railroad Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1923.

ACT NO. 542.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to provide for co-operative soil survey work between the Federal Bureau of Soil and the Arkansas Experiment Station.

Authorizes the director of the Experiment Station of the College of Agriculture to expend such sums as are appropriated by this Act for the purpose of conducting a scientific investigation of the soil survey of the State, classifying and locating the different soils and making surveys and maps thereof.

Authorizes said director to employ competent assistant soil survey men, to fix their compensation and to purchase necessary supplies. Authorizes the county courts to make appropriations out of the general revenue fund of the counties for the purpose of co-operating with the said Experiment Station for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of this Act.

Appropriates the sum of \$7,500.00 for said work for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1922, and appropriates the sum of \$7,500.00 for said work for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1923.

ACT NO. 543.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to make appropriations for carrying out the work of the Arkansas Illiteracy Commission.

Appropriates the sum of \$8,000.00 out of the general revenue fund for paying for work already done and expenses already incurred by the Arkansas Illiteracy Commission, for the completion of said records and paying salaries and expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1922.

Appropriates the sum of \$5,000.00 for salaries, printing, postage and other necessary expenses of said Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1923.

ACT NO. 544.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to provide for temporary school buildings and other necessary changes for the Arkansas Deaf Mute Institute.

Appropriates the sum of \$5,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the erection of a temporary school building for the Arkansas Deaf Mute Institute.

ACT NO. 545.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to make appropriation for the addition to the hospital at the Arkansas Confederate Home.

Appropriates the sum of \$14,000.00 for an addition to the hospital at the Confederate Home for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1922.

Appropriates the sum of \$1,000.00 for addition to the hospital for the Confederate Home for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1923.

ACT NO. 547.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to amend Section 768 of Crawford & Moses Digest.

Amends said section which provides for reports of investment companies to the Bank Commissioner so as to provide that Building & Loan Associations shall file an annual statement as of December 31st of each year.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act for the maintenance of the Arkansas National Guard.

Appropriates the sum of \$37,900.00 for salaries and necessary expenses of the office of the Adjutant General for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1922.

Appropriates the sum of \$31,900.00 for salaries and necessary expenses of the office of the Adjutant General for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1923.

ACT NO. 549.

Approved March 26, 1921.
An Act to make appropriations for the maintenance of the State Auditorial Department.
