AN INN'S SECRET.

Sample of How Warrants Were Prepared

in Old Times. During the work of rebuilding the Royal Bull hotel of Dartford, England, an old hostelry and landmark, some interesting discoveries were made last month, says the Baltimore Sun. In 1773 a murder had been committed at the house and the body disappeared mysteriously. A skeleton now dug up, three feet below the flooring of an old cellar, eleads to the belief that it was the remains of the victim of the tragedy. A secret staircase was brought to light, and, as this communicates by invisible doors in the walls of the cellar with the room in which the tragedy occurred, it strengthens the belief that the body was taken down the staircase and buried. At the same time a number of death warrants, bearing the signature of Portland, minister of George III., were found in the panels of the walls in which the murder was committed. How documents of this character got into so strange a hiding place is a matter for conjecture. One, dated June, 1798, is a good sample of how warrants were prepared in those days. 
