WILL MURPHY STICK?

In its issue of Monday last the Phoenix Republican publishes, under far-flung headlines, a special telegram from Washington which opens with the following paragraph:
'The fight for the removal of Governor Murphy is confined to his personal enemies in Arizona. There is no echo of it in Washington. No charges have been filed, and it is the intention of the administration to have him serve out his term.'

TO USE ELECTRICITY.

It is highly probable that in the course of the next few years electricity will take the place of steam in supplying power for much of the machinery about the mines in the Lake Superior copper district. It is claimed that the work of many smaller engines about the mines could be done by electricity at a much lessened cost. The principal saving would be fuel. At many of the mines in this district experiments are under way upon the results of which much will depend as regards future changes.

The cattle outlook is splendid. So far as the market and the demand are concerned it is difficult to see where more inducements could be offered to the breeder than at present. There is a shortage in the supply, while the population has increased and great foreign markets have been opened up. This demand will be steady for years to come, and with the visible supply of cattle 10,000,000 less than it was ten years ago, the future has many years to roll by before the supply can possibly exceed the demand. Young men, get you a bunch of cows and live with them. In the language of a corn belt father in giving advice to his son: 'Get a cow; hang to her tail for twenty years and you can buy us all out.'

For ancient lineage China takes the premium. The current representative of the Confucius family is the seventh in lineal descent from the sage. The headship of the family has been carried with it the title of prince since 220 B. C. No European family is more than four hundred years old in spite of all the 'come in with the conqueror' gush. It may be remarked that no member of the Confucius family has amounted to anything except the founder.

Copper Queen Injunction Suit.

The Copper Queen tax injunction suit will come up before Judge Davis on Thursday afternoon. We have already expressed our disapproval of the action of the Board of Supervisors. The Copper Queen company is not credited with more than one tenth of the total mineral production of the territory, and, yet, it is called upon to pay as much as all the other mines put together. This would appear on its face to be discrimination against a corporation which certainly deserves better treatment. We believe the gross value of the Copper Queen production last year at its furnaces was approximately \$4,000,000. The assessment on its property is \$2,333,034. We conceive that no merchant would consent to pay taxes on his total sales, yet such a method of valuation would even be more reasonable than that adopted in the case of the Copper Queen, for a stock of merchandise can be replaced, but the value of a mining claim, if it is worked, is absolutely and permanently reduced by every pound of ore extracted. The arbitrary value put on the claims of the Copper Queen company expresses this difference very forcibly and demonstrates the impossibility of assessing property on such an evanescent value from merely public rumor. We have examined the assessment roll and find that claims, which we know were long ago worked out, are taxed on their reputation rather than their value. We refer to these anomalies merely as a proof of the difficulties which inevitably attend this method of assessing values for taxable properties and the injustice, and, therefore, litigation which is certain to ensue.

In the present instance the people of the county are deeply concerned, inasmuch as the county returns have been made to the territorial board of equalization on this enormously high valuation, which the Copper Queen certainly cannot be expected to admit. The territorial levy being made on this extravagant valuation will leave the county treasury empty and involve among other hardships, the closing of the public schools long before the school year actually expires. The Copper Queen company has never defaulted in its payments to the public. On the other hand it has been noted for its liberality, and, therefore, we are certain that it will be willing to relieve the county of the embarrassment in which it has been involved by the discriminating and arbitrary action of the Board of Supervisors, if any way can be suggested of its doing so, without weakening its legal position or admitting liabilities, which is certainly justified in submitting to the court for adjudication before paying them.
