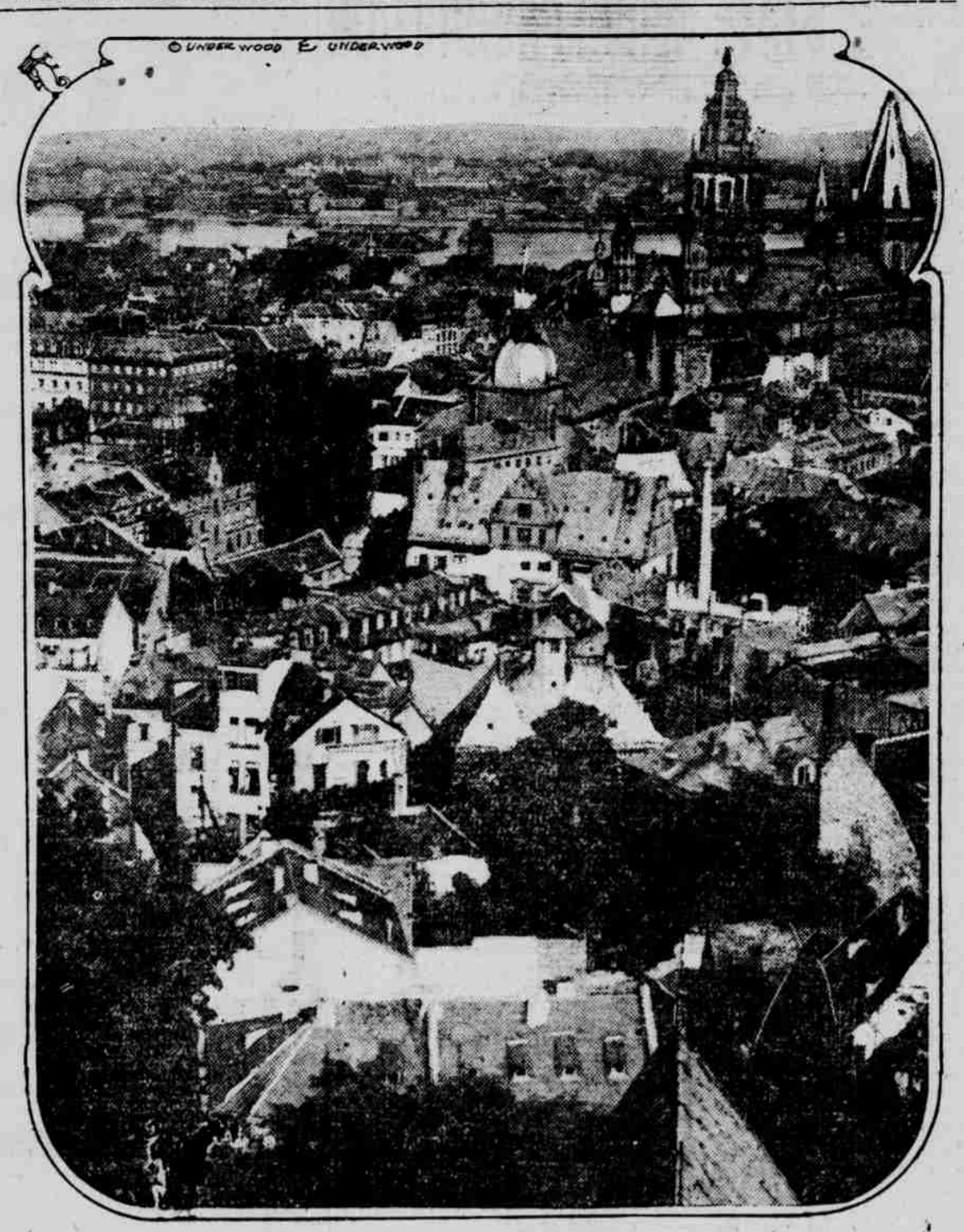

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business proposed to be transacted by this corporation and in which it is to engage is that of doing a general hardware and implement business, buying and selling all kinds of merchandise and real and personal property of every kind and character and description; borrowing money and contracting to pay the same at such time or times and at such rate of interest as its Board of Directors may deem advisable, and to secure the payment of the same by mortgage, pledge, or otherwise, on any or all of the property of the corporation; and to transact any and all kinds of business that may be transacted by a natural person.

ARTICLE III

The amount of the capital stock authorized by this corporation is Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000). It shall be divided into five hundred (500) shares and the par value of each share shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100). The times when and the conditions upon which it shall be paid are as follows: The whole thereof within thirty (30) days after the same has been subscribed for, provided that the Board of Directors of said Company may accept merchantable hardware at such prices as they may deem proper in part or full payment for any subscription to the stock of this corporation.
