THE RICH WHO GIVE

A Defense of this Class by Jacob H. Schiff, a Well Known Observer

Jacob H. Schiff was one of the guests of honor at the dinner of the New York Post-graduate Medical school at Delmonico's last night.

"I was invited to the peace banquet," said he, "but I decided that I would rather be with you. After all, this is an efficient meeting as the congress. You, who try to cure diseased minds and bodies, are the true missionaries of peace."

Then he took as his text an announcement made earlier in the evening by Dr. G. N. Miller, secretary of the institution. The Jones bequest of from \$110,000 to \$115,000 will be paid next week with \$25,000 to come later.

"This will reduce the debt on the Post-graduate hospital to \$300,000. Mr. Schiff congratulated the institution, and proceeded to express his views upon the beneficence of the wealthy.

"If only rich men," he said, "who do so much for education and art would do something for the medical schools they would effect more good. They should support not only the schools attached to universities, but those situated in great cities, where the material for medical study is plentiful.

"We hear much of the responsibility of the classes to the masses. Gentlemen, I am not sure whether the masses do their duty as thoroughly as do the classes. I am filled with admiration for me like Rockefeller and Morgan and the others of whom Dr. Miller spoke. They have great fortunes, but they direct their diffusion rightly. Their wealth is like a reservoir, into which run little streams from the mountains, which of themselves would be of no use to mankind."

Mr. Schiff then pointed out that the medical profession could do much to assist the classes in the management of the wealth they had collected from the masses by showing the general run of mankind that it was a good thing that the means of doing things had been concentrated in the hands of the few who could use them wisely.

"You doctors," he said, "who come

into touch with all classes, cannot do better than to teach toleration of the wealthy man. At present the men who have gathered great fortunes are indiscriminately condemned.

"I congratulate you on what you have accomplished. The city and country have the right to be proud of your achievements. Those who come from Europe may say there is here too much business, too much rush. But when they see for palaces and castles let them look at our universities and libraries—even if they are Carnegie libraries. Let them listen to our men of science. They are our real princes."

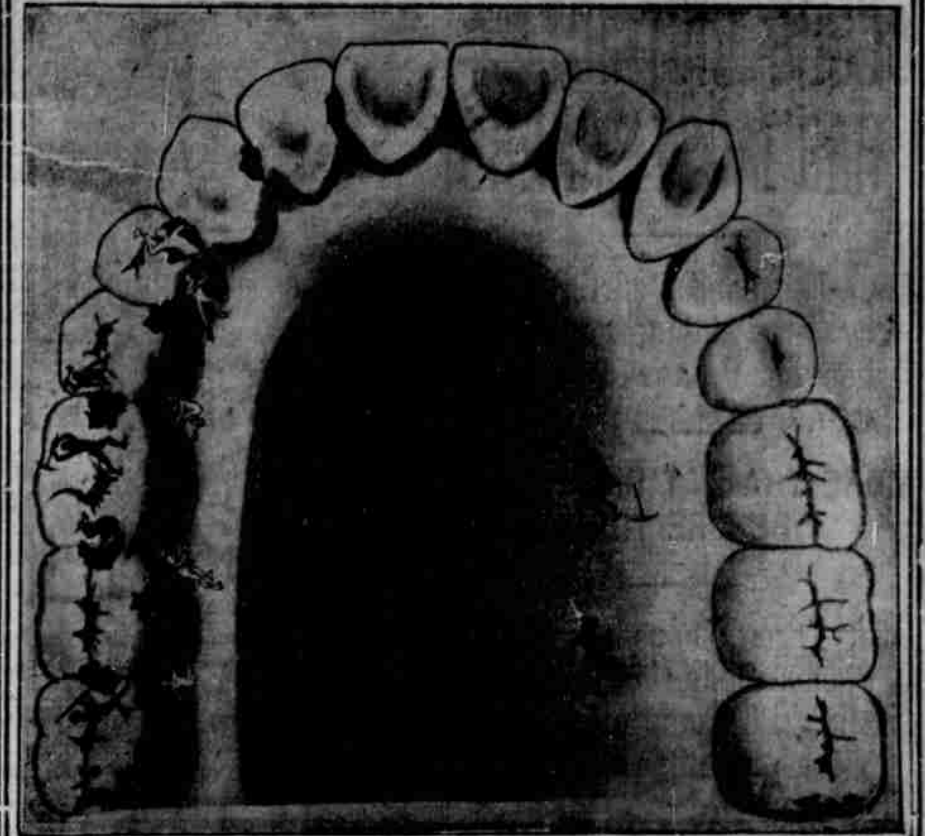
