ORDINANCE NO. TWENTY-SEVEN

An Ordinance Relating to the Numbering of Houses.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Globe:

SECTION I.

It is hereby made the duty of every household, owner, occupant or other person having charge or control of any house within the City of Globe, to maintain upon each such house, in conspicuous places, such number or numbers as may be required, designated and furnished by the City of Globe.

For each number designated, furnished and placed in position such household, occupant or agent shall pay the City the sum of fifty cents.

The said houses shall be numbered on a basis of one hundred numbers, divided equally per block, and distributed consecutively and proportionally on either side of the street in each block, the odd numbers being upon the east and south sides of the streets respectively, and the even numbers being upon the north and west sides of the streets, as nearly as may be.

SECTION II.

It is hereby made the duty of the Superintendent of Streets to superintend the numbering of houses as aforesaid and the collecting thereof.

SECTION III.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
