

GREAT NEW PLANT IS BUILDING FOR MAXWELL-CHALMERS

DETROIT, June 20.—Work has been started at the Oakland avenue site of the Maxwell-Chalmers corporation, which comprises about thirty acres of land between Ferrand and Massachusetts avenues, for the erection of an automobile plant which will cost in the neighborhood of \$10,000,000 and have facilities for the employment of between 15,000 and 20,000 men.

The present plant which consists of several one-story buildings will be gradually razed and the buildings of the new plant will take their place. It is planned to increase the output of the Oakland avenue plant of the company to 600 cars a day. The present capacity is about 100.

The new plant will be made up of eleven shops and a loading dock. The company also has plans under consideration for a new office building on Oakland avenue and a large power house.
