SLAUGHTER.

Effects of the Deadly Northern Heat. Killing Men and Horses Fill the Streets. Condition Aggravated by gusty South Winds.

Previous Records of Suffering prostration and Death in Chicago Eclipse.

July 27.—[Associated Press.] Slaughter by the sun was still on in Arizona today, fifty deaths and more were as many prostrations from heat occurring, and although there is prediction of a cold wave, a majority of relief, it is certain the number of deaths will be largely increased during the next few days.

The record of yesterday, which surpassed anything in the number of deaths in Arizona, was eclipsed by the heat of the day in and about the city and in the shade 92° to 94° and wind was from the south, and a majority of the casualties were among the poorer classes.
