*Medal for Merit is Awarded
Truman K. Gibson, Jr.*

In the name of the President, the Secretary of War, the Honorable Henry L. Stimson recently presented the Medal for Merit for Civilians to Mr. Truman K. Gibson, Jr., Civilian Aide to the Secretary of War since September, 1943, at ceremonies in his office in the Pentagon building.

Following is the citation which accompanied the award:

"For the performance of extraordinary service to the War Department in handling for the Secretary of War as a special advisor the problem of the fair and effective utilization of Negroes in all branches of the military service including the employment of Negroes in a civilian status.

"In the performance of his duties, he exercised at all times a strong sense of fairness and moderation and a rare human understanding. His counsel has been of great value to the War Department in its efforts to effect the greatest possible utilization of Negroes in the Army. He has set a high standard of useful service in the field of racial relations in time of war for which the War Department and the nation are grateful."
