## LOW RATES TO THE COLORADO STATE FAIR, PUEBLO.

On the occasion of the Colorado Tenth Annual State Fair to be held in Pueblo, September 19th, to 24th, 1910, inclusive, the Denver & Rio Grande Railroad will make a rate of one fare for the round trip from all points in Colorado. ## MENDING GRAIN SACKS.

"I have several hundred grain sacks and they often become torn and have to be mended," says a writer in Field and Farm. "I used to spend a good deal of time sewing them so they would answer the purpose for which they were intended but I quit it. I now mend with paste. I simply make a flour paste and paste the patch on and then run a hot iron over it. This cooks the paste and cements the patch to the sack in a way that is lasting and satisfactory. If kept dry it will wear as long as the rest of the sack."
