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BAR DESTROYED BY FLAMES

Valuable Horse Burned to Death in Fire Early Sunday Morning—North Main Street Houses Threatened and Fire Alarm Telegraph Wires Got Down.

Fire of unknown origin totally destroyed the barn in the rear of No. 171 North Main street, early Sunday morning. A valuable horse owned by Augustina Lacavera, fruit dealer, was burned to death in stall as it was impossible to get the unfortunate animal out of the burning structure.

The flames, which started about 7 o'clock Sunday morning, were broken by the heat and the building occupied by Cunningham's saloon caught, but the flames were quickly quenched by the streams which were pouring on the scorched structure.
