PAUPER LAW UNDER STATE TREASURER

With the signing of the bill relating to the care of state paupers by Governor Holcomb late Wednesday afternoon, the administration of the state pauper law is transferred from the comptroller to the state treasurer. The bill authorizes the treasurer to appoint an official to take care of the work of administration under the supervision of the treasurer. The salary of the position is \$2,000 a year.
