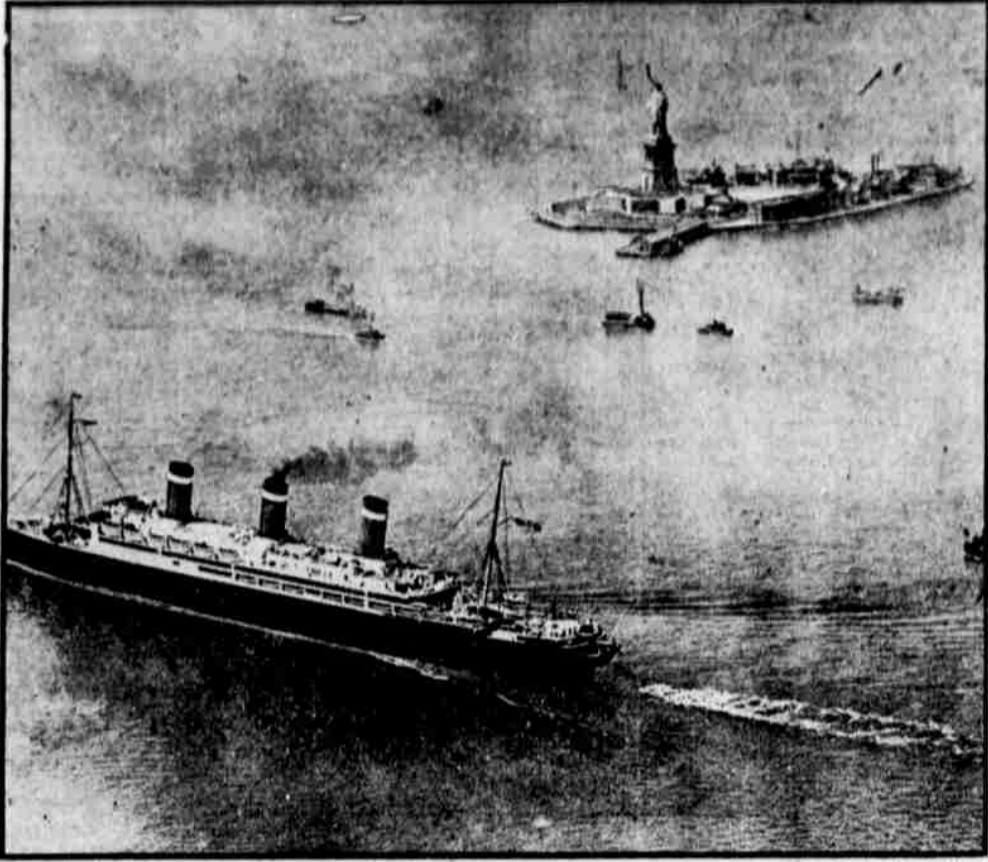


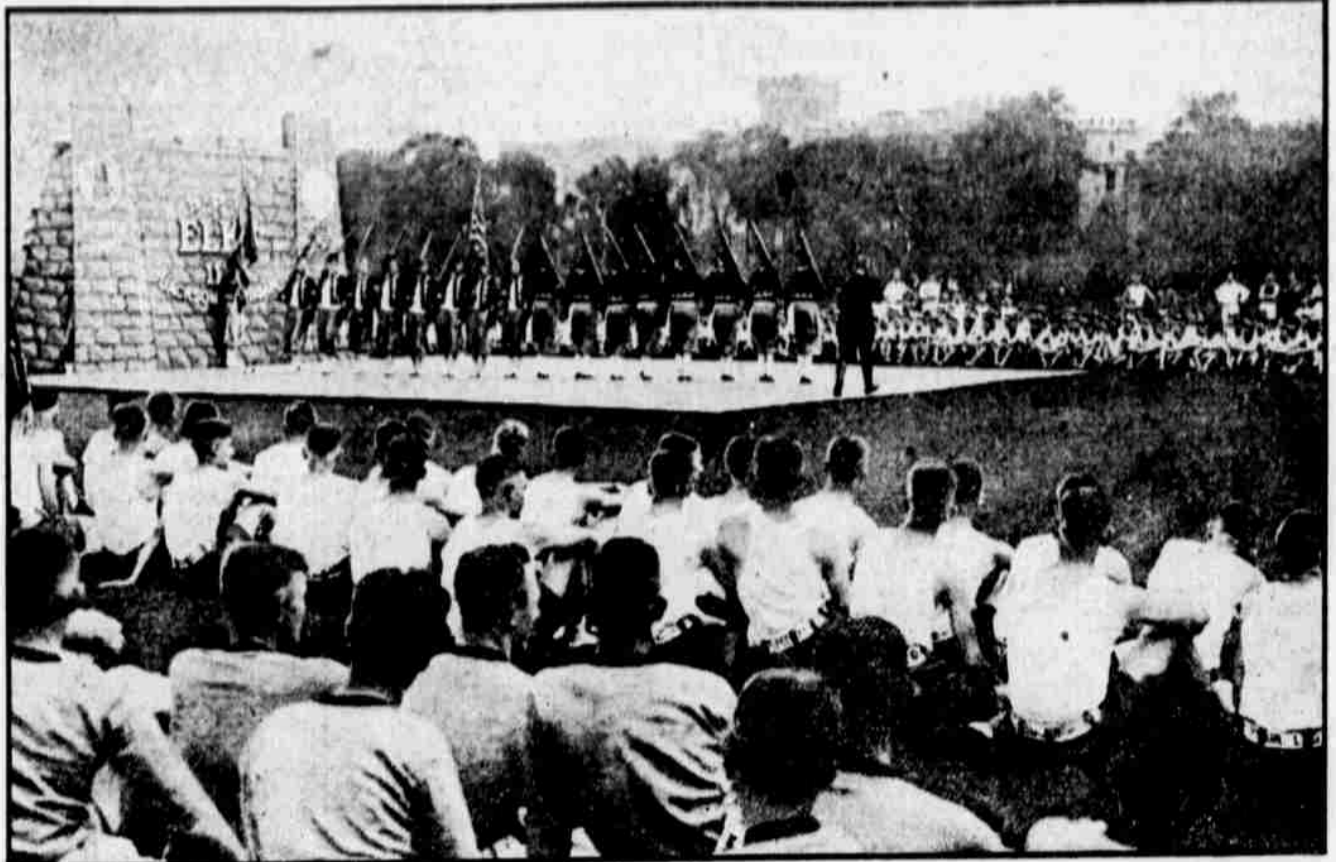

Two Symbols of Our Country



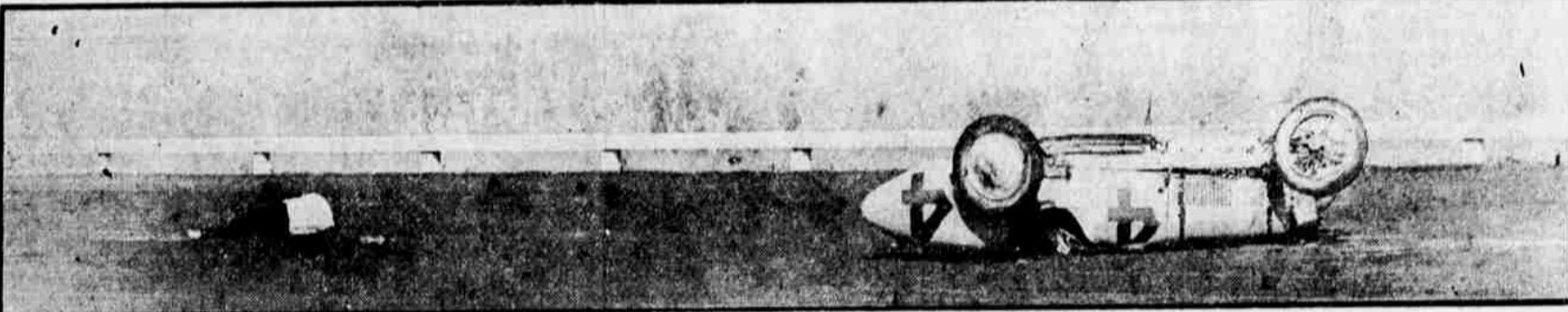

One Killed, Many Hurt in Crash



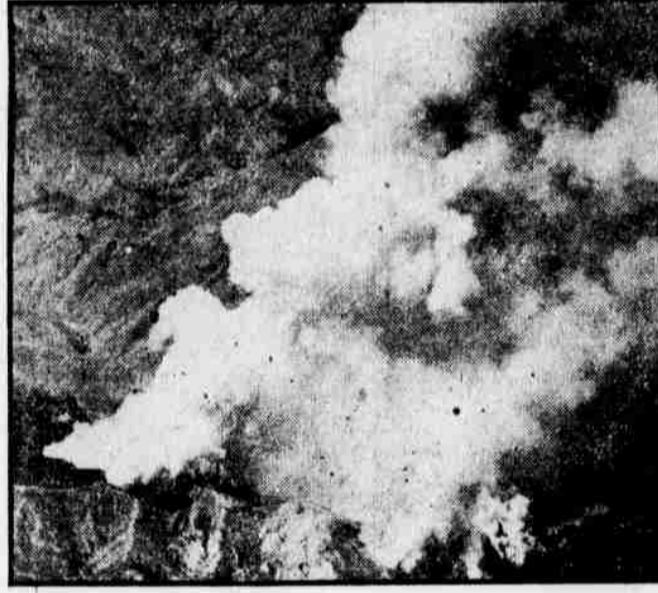
One man was killed and many passengers hurt when two excursion trains piled up in crash in Spokane, Wash. Misunderstanding of orders is blamed.
