PORTS COMMISSION MEETS IN PARIS

Paris, Wednesday, March 26.—An official statement issued by the commission on the international regime of ports, waterways and railways tonight, says:

The commission heard representatives of the Dutch government in regard to plans for the navigation of the Rhine. The Dutch point of view was presented by W. J. M. Van Eysinga, professor at the University of Leyden."

TWO WAYS OF MAKING WAR.

THAT EUROPEAN TOUR.

Workers are busy at the winter quarters of the Barnum & Bailey circus here getting together apparatus and other material so essential to a white top show for the foreign run. The apparatus is being shipped to London as soon as completed, so that when the current season of the circus here closes next Fall, only the performers will need to be transported there.

The Barnum show will play London for several months and then move to Paris and the larger cities in France. From that country it will go to Rome, Naples, Florence and Genoa in Italy. Arrangements are now being made for stops at other European cities. The tour will include also cities in Japan, China and Manila. The show will return in 1920 via San Francisco. The season of 1920 will be spent in the Western field.

While the Barnum show is playing Europe, the Ringling Brothers organization will be making its annual tour of American cities. It is probable that when the Barnum show returns from its globe trot, the Ringling combination will be sent to South America for a year.

There's a long poem in our language book called The Shepherd and His Dog, and yesterday Miss Kitty told the class to read it for homework...

"Part of the program will be put into operation commencing April 15, and the other part beginning May 1."

"The commission continued the investigation of the charges to be asserted in the treaty of peace in regard to ports under international control."

"Therefore, they argued, the more cruel and barbarous we are, the less suffering we inflict. Thus cruelty becomes in the long run the most humane method of carrying on war, because it ends the war the most quickly."

"The American theory of making war is a chivalrous one. It is to conform strictly to international law, to show all possible consideration for non-combatants, to have mercy on women and children, to secure the safekeeping wherever possible, to the Germans such a theory of war making is mere weakness and softness of heart. You can never make successful war in any such namby-pamby fashion as that, they said."

"The German theory broke down in practice. The more barbarous they were, the more they excited the implacable anger of their adversaries the more they drew in neutrals to fight against them. Every time they sent a Zeppelin over London and Paris to murder women and children, it brought thousands of men to the recruiting stations. This theory was thus proved to be the monstrous product of an overheated arrogant, and self-centered imagination. They defeated themselves by their savage acts."

"American Chivalry has proved the most efficient form of war making. It appeals to the wisdom, the humanity, the justice and the common sense of the race, and wins adherents where barbarity creates new enemies."




