Mrs. R.—The Fairbanks divorce was a mutual affair. The boy, who is in the custody of Mrs. Fairbanks, is about eight years old.

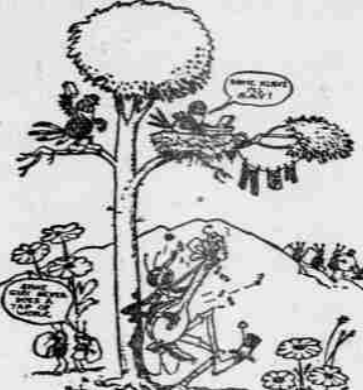
L. K.—Madeline Travers is no longer in pictures. She may return but we're not sure.

Beauty Chats

ROUND SHOULDER EXERCISES. There are two ways of getting rid of a round shoulder, the appearance of one is to learn to sleep flat on the back without a pillow, the other to exercise so as to strengthen the weak muscles.

As you are probably asleep, or at least in bed, for eight hours every day, which is a third of the entire time, you will greatly improve your shoulders by learning to sleep without a pillow, with the back straight. Some people advocate that all beauty exercise should be taken while asleep; that is, you should never sleep unless the skin has been freed from the day's dirt and unless you are breathing fresh air and so forth.

Try this exercise: Stand with the hands out in front of you and the feet a few inches apart. Bring the hands back to the shoulders tensing the arm muscles as though you were pulling on a weight. Or, stand with the feet a few inches apart and the hands open the arms sideways and continue the motion so the arms go back as far as possible, always keeping the feet on the floor.

Incidentally, remember to keep the shoulders back and the chest high when you are standing or walking. S. F. A.—To your glycerine mixture, add as much rose water and five drops of lemon juice as you can. This combination will bleach the skin as it softens it.

Bluebird.—Fluff the hair out softly over the temples and upper part of the ears. It may seem flat for a time, but it is in better style than puffs. Greens and browns are your colors. Jay.—Nothing will remove freckles permanently, as the sun is constantly bringing out these little spots, which are so difficult as you seem to think. You can bleach them some, by using lemon juice or that from cucumbers or strawberries.

Bluebird.—Your skin needs an astringent. A small piece of ice rubbed over the skin until it glows will stop this oily condition, or a few drops of benzoin to a quart of water, used as a rinse after bathing. You can increase your weight by taking olive oil and grape juice, three times each day at meals. A tablespoonful of each will be enough.

Efficient Housekeeping

"Please publish one of your 'Just how' recipes for a Coconut Layer Cake," writes a bride reader of this column. Here is my reply:

Coconut Layer Cake: Cream together 1/2 cup of butter and 1 cup of granulated sugar; add 1/2 cup of milk. Now sift together 2 1/2 cups of flour, 2 teaspoons baking powder and 1/2 teaspoon salt and mix in the stiffly-beaten whites of 2 eggs and flavor with 1 teaspoon of vanilla.

Put between these layers the following: Coconut Cream Filling for a two-layer cake: (This will make just enough for one cake.) Heat 3/4 of a cup of sweet milk in a small saucepan. Now take 1/2 cup of more sweet milk and mix into it 4 tablespoons of flour; when stirred smooth, add this thickening to the hot milk, stirring constantly. Have ready in a small bowl 1 well-beaten egg which has been mixed with 6 tablespoons of granulated sugar and a pinch of salt. Add this to the mixture a few seconds after adding the flour. When thick, stir in 1 cup of shredded coconut and let cook a minute longer.

Then remove from range and add 1 teaspoon vanilla. (This filling is apt to catch at the bottom and burn unless it is stirred between two cold or hot layers (it makes no difference which) and proceed to make the following icing:

Just Enough Coconut Icing for One Layer Cake: Beat 1 egg in a medium-sized mixing bowl, ready to have hot sirup poured into it. Now make the sirup in this way: Mix together 2 tablespoons of boiling water and 4 tablespoons of granulated sugar in a small saucepan and let them boil without stirring until a little will "thread" from a spoon when it is held high in the air and dripped into the saucepan. If you have the inexperienced, I might say that this "thread" is an almost invisible spider web-like ending of the drop of sirup after it has just left the edge of the spoon.) When this stage is reached take the saucepan off the fire at once and pour the hot sirup rapidly, using an egg beater of the wheel type, and after one full minute of beating add 1/2 cup of shredded coconut. Spread at once over the top layer.

Many housekeepers prefer to make double this quantity of icing and put half of it between the two layers and the other half on top—thus obviating the necessity of making a separate filling. But to my mind it is well worth while to take the trouble to make the cream filling I have given above (which is somewhat like a custard filling, light yellow in color) as it gives a little more variety to the cake and is softer.

If the beginner wishes to be doubly sure of success with the Coconut Cream Filling that she is sure that it will not catch and burn) she may cook it in her double boiler instead of over direct heat, allowing it to cook over the boiling water for 15 minutes before adding the flavoring.

Summer Recipes

Blackberry Jam. Use three-quarters of a pound of sugar to one pound of fruit. Put the fruit over the fire and for two quarts add the juice of one lemon.

Cook until the fruit bursts open, and mash meanwhile. Add the desired amount of sugar, set aside over night and cook down the next morning until quite thick and of the desired consistency.
