ACCIDENT IN A TUNNEL

Two Men Killed by Suffoyation and Caisson Disease and Two Drowned.

RESULT OF PIPE BURSTING

Two Persons Seriously Over-come and Two Others Suffered Severly.

SIX HOISTED TO THE SURFACE

e Bodies of the Drowned Men Still at the Bottom of the Shaft

Was the Seene of the Accident—The Dead Were Negro Laborers.

New York, Jan. 16.—Two negro tunnel workers were killed by suffocation and caisson disease, two were drowned, two were seriously overcome and the white foreman and his assistant suffered severely in rescuing those who survived, when a compressed air pipe burst in the East River Tunnel, on Man-o'-War Reef, opposite Forty-second street, early today. The bodies of the two drowned men still lie at the bottom of the shaft, 20 fest below the river's level. These men were overwhelmed by the water that entered the shaft when the pressure was removed. The other two dead men were helsted to the surface by the foreman and his assistant, who also rescued the two whose lives were saved. The foreman and his assistant left the bottom of the shaft and were boisted to the river's level, with the bodies, just in time to escape drowning and death by the "bends," as the dreaded onlieson disease is called.

Man-o'-War Reef is a mass of rooks lying just below the surface of the river at lew water. When it was fixed upon as the place for a shaft, a crib was built, which was made air-tight, and by dumping rocks from the other shafts upon it the contractors have made a little island for the work there. From this the shaft, when Harold R. Shallers, the foreman, who was at the surface, discovered that something was wrong in the tunnel. He entered a bucket and was lowered down the shaft into the lower compartment, passing through an air look, which permits the high pressure of air upon the walks of the compartment had ceased.

Shallers placed two of the sagroes in the bucket and gave the signal for housting it to the surface. When the bucket was again lowered into the shaft, the foreman's assistant, Carl Verbecke, came with it. They placed two more men in the bucket, and then Shallers fell to the ground, unconscious. His assistant was barely able to place him in the bucket, crawl in and give the hoisting signal. The other two were left in the compartment. It is believed that they were already dead, as were the two who were brought to the surface on the final trip. Shallers recovered consolous, near at the top of the shaft. He was put under arrest by the coroner, but was paroled in the ouslody of the superintendent of the work and remained on the teef. The shaft must be pumped out and the air pressure restored before the bodies can be resched.
