MOORE ADMITS C. & D. LEGISLATION IS OFF

President's Suggestion For River and Harbor Economy Delays Proposal

OPPOSE CHANGE IN COURT CLERKS

WASHINGTON, Jan. 28.—Representative Moore, president of the Atlantic Deepwaterways Association, admitted yesterday that the Chesapeake and Delaware Canal legislation was postponed by the suggestion of the President to avoid taking up new projects at this session, and the decision of the rivers and harbors committee to yield to the President's wishes.

"We have realized from the beginning of this session," said Mr. Moore, "that what are called 'new projects' would have had stalling in view of the administration's economy program. We are up against the projects already started and upon which work must be continued to avoid loss and deterioration. The 35-foot project on the Delaware is one of these, and, of course, it is important to hold that project in the bill."

A memorial from the Board of Trade of Philadelphia, protesting against the so-called Shields' bill, for the appointment of the clerks of the Circuit and District Courts of the United States by the President instead of as at present by the judges, was filed in the House by Congressman Moore.

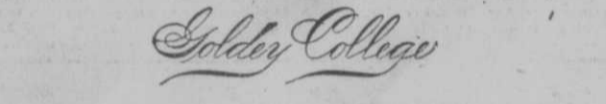
