**BULLET FOR COOK'S CRITIC.**  
 Poor Aim Saves Presumptuous Colored Steamship Fireman.  
 Jacob Downing, colored, twenty-five years of age, employed as a cook on the steamer Westmoreland, which plies between Washington and Baltimore, is a prisoner at the Fourth precinct police station, charged with assault with intent to kill William Brooker, also colored, a fireman on the same vessel. Brooker escaped injury.  
 While the Westmoreland was lying at her wharf at the foot of Eleventh Street, about 3 o'clock yesterday morning, Brooker entered the messroom and called for breakfast. It was served him, but did not suit his taste, and in expressing his dissatisfaction remarked that Downing would "make a better cook heavier than cook." This offended Downing, and he remarked:  
 "I'll be back in a minute," and went out on deck.  
 Going to his berth, he secured a revolver, and returning to the messroom is alleged to have fired at the negro. The bullet went wild, and before he could fire again, he was seized by the crew and held until a policeman arrived.
