

STOCK MARKET COMMENT

The Morgan Boom Attracting Almost Universal Attention.

A Far Greater Upward Movement Than That Achieved by Flower

Two Years Ago—Belief That Prices Are "Heard" Up by the Syndicates.

NEW YORK, March 31.—Wall Street is attracting more attention than at any time before since the Flower boom two years ago.

The Morgan boom is far greater than that of the Flower market in every way inclusive of its spectacular effects.

The trade denouement of the Flower boom in the death of its principal actor is not likely to be counteracted in the present campaign, however, and it is therefore to be hoped that such a tremendous smash of prices as followed Mr. Flower's death will be looking ahead in the climax of the present market.

But that there is a possibility of a counter-trend in the present market, in greater or less degree, this element exists in the present market. But it is not a controlling factor—certainly not in any large part in this outside element is skeptical over the market and sells, therefore, quite as readily as it buys.
