

12 SAVING THE ADIRONDACKS.

ACTION OF THE NEW-YORK COMMITTEE. SECRET SESSION AT THE CHAMBERS OF COMMERCE.—CONFERENCE WITH SENATOR KOCH.

The committee of the Chamber of Commerce met at noon yesterday, to confer with Senator Koch on the question of forming the forest of the State...

The object of the bill is the preservation of the forests and the water ways of the State. The bill would require the segregation of the lands belonging to the State within a certain belt included in Herkimer, Franklin, Essex, Fulton, Hamilton, St. Lawrence, Lewis, Clinton, Saratoga and Warren counties...

I believe our committee will be able to do more than purchase but, at first, I think they may have favored some purchases at points that would have been considered riparian rights. The majority of people have an idea that the State forest lands are something like the Central Park, only more extensive...

The bill will give to the Land Commissioners of the new department or bureau authority to buy, to lease, to convey and to prevent any action on the part of these private owners that shall be detrimental to the waterways or the fuel lands of the State. For the purpose of getting a good lead of water, when they are going to 'beat down their trees...

THE ALDERMEN STUBBORN. DEMOCRATIC FACTIONS REFUSE TO YIELD ANYTHING.

The Democratic factions in the new Board of Aldermen seem to meet on the ground of the organization. The County Democracy members are very emphatic in their declaration that they will not yield to Tammany, while the Tammany men say that they will not yield to the County Democracy...

Mr. Smith gave the following statement regarding his embarrassment: "The firm of B. R. Smith & Co. was dissolved last October, mainly for the purpose of closing up several old accounts, there being large claims due the firm. In 1879 the firm had suspended payment for three days only and afterward paid 100 cents on the dollar.
