NOTE OF PRAISE

Managers of Exhibition at Convention Hall Are Congratulated Today.

Members of the Washington Automobile Dealers' Association today are being congratulated on the successful opening of their show Monday night.

While thousands of people stood at attention in Convention Hall, President Wilson, at his office in the White House, at 8 o'clock, touched the button establishing a direct connection with the show.

The display of cars is impressive, and the power-plant exhibition, representing thirty different makes, there is also a display of trucks, while the thousand-and-one things that add to pleasure and comfort are exhibited.

Lighting Effects Good.

Never before have the decorations and lighting effects been as beautiful as at the present show. The color scheme is gold and white. The entire ceiling of Convention Hall is canopied in these colors, and the same effect is carried out on the side walls.

The crowd last night is said to be the largest that has ever attended any previous event of the kind here, and it is estimated 10,000 people were in the hall during the evening.

As for the display of cars and accessories the concert given by the Marine Band, under the leadership of Lieut. W. H. Santomest, was one of the features of the evening.

The show will be open each day from 10:30 o'clock in the morning to 10:30 at night, and there will be concerts by the band every afternoon and evening.

Sold First Car.

There was rivalry among the dealers as to who would make the first sale at the show. It was a close race between the Hudson Automobile Company and the Prober-Haynes Company.

Among the factory representatives attending the show are George H. Strout, general sales manager of the Hayes Automobile Company, and John H. Strout, of the Motor Car Company, Indianapolis.

The Washington show is one of the best I have ever seen, and the promoters are to be congratulated on the way in which they have arranged the exhibition.
