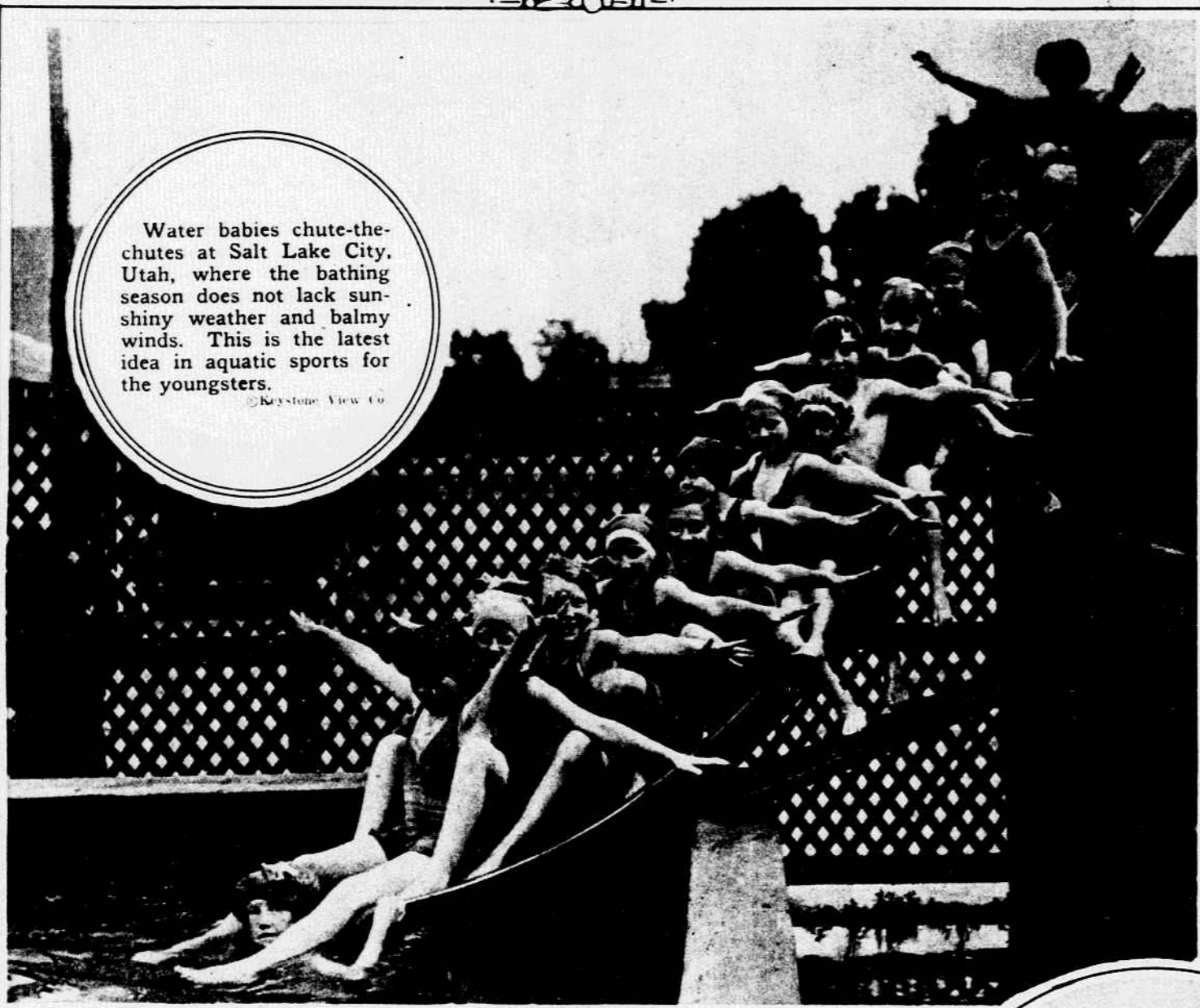
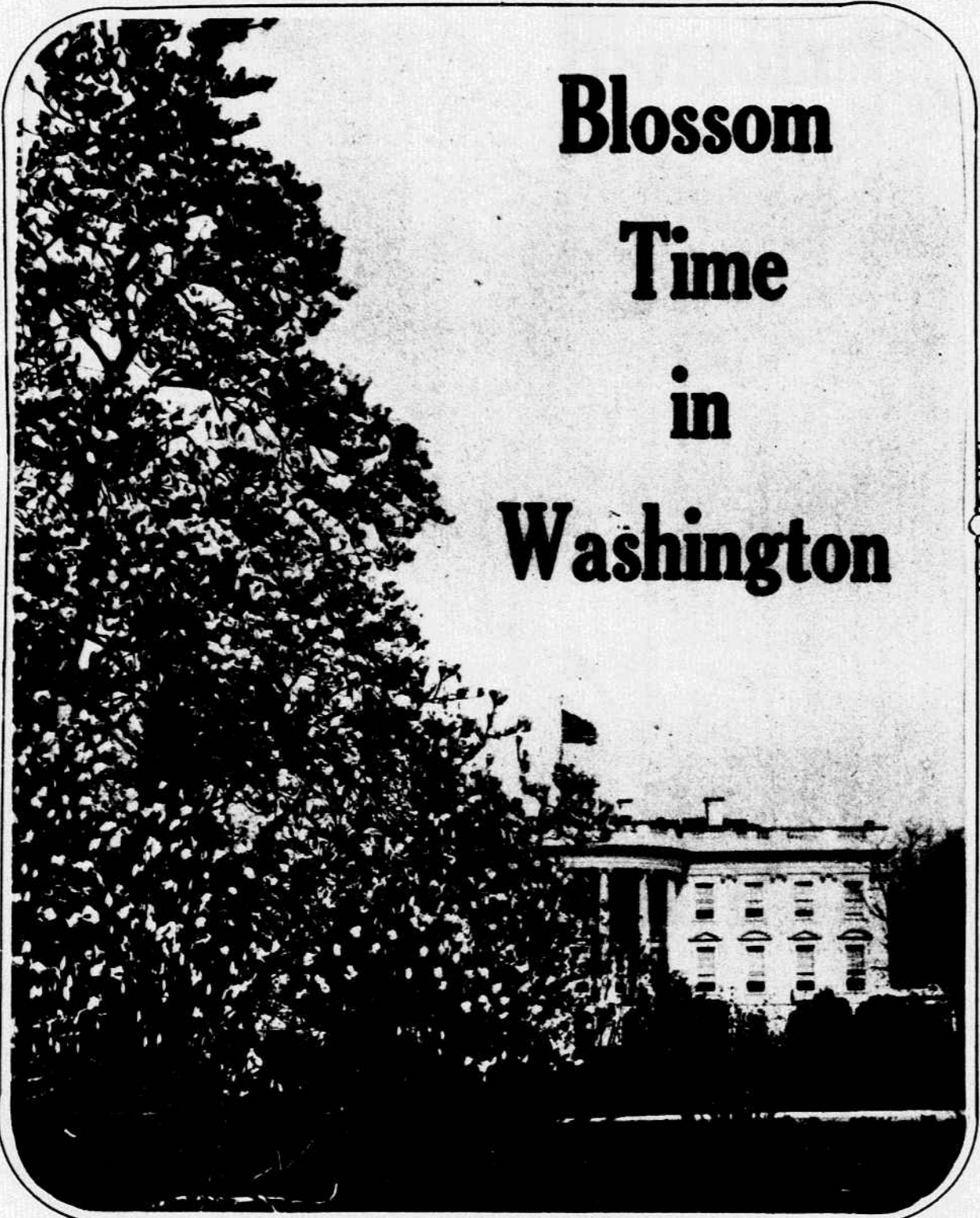


Blossom Time in Washington
