against Godoy, the abdication of Carlos IV., the assumption of the throne by Ferdinand VII., his son, the entrance of the French army into Spain, and the following war of independence.

Notwithstanding these ever-recurring insurrections, there has been in Spain, up to the present century, no serious revolution, except the war of the Holy League in the times of Carlos I., or Charles V., as the Germans call him.

The material basis of the Spanish monarchy having been laid by the union of Arragon, Castile and Grenada, under Ferdinand the Catholic, and Isabella I., Charles I. attempted to transform that still feudal monarchy into an absolute one.

Simultaneously he attacked the two pillars of the monarchy, the Cortes and the Ayuntamientos—the former a modification of the ancient Gothic councils, and the latter transmitted almost without interruption from the Roman times.

On the one side, small parts of the peninsula were recovered at a time, and formed into separate kingdoms, during the long struggles with the Arabs. Popular laws and customs were engendered in these struggles.
