WILD SCENES ON THE FIELD
Thousands of Noise-Making Devices Made the Air Hideous and Throats Were Strained in Cheering the Victors—From Start to Finish the Baltimore Were Doomed.

Ball Park, Cleveland, O., Oct. 3.—Nothing approaching the exhibition of enthusiasm at League Park this afternoon has ever before been seen at a public exhibition in this city.

It was more than enthusiasm. Fans in thousands pressed for a more direct way of expressing their love for the animals. The collection of noise-making devices that passed through the turnstiles was a sight to behold. There were big horns and little horns; big bells and other unbridled devices, that emitted sounds that beggar description.

The effect rendered the unwilling listeners of a noise that several hundred combined voices might make. The animals were all turned loose. The most conspicuous device was a horn made of sheet iron that seven men carried into the pavilion from the right of the grand stand.
