IRRIGATION OF ARID LANDS.

Representative Sweet Reports a Bill from the House Committee. Representative Sweet, of Idaho, has reported from the House Committee on Irrigation of Arid Lands the bill agreed upon by Western members for a survey of the arid lands and estimates of the cost of reclamation. The surveys proposed are: In Idaho, the land and water in the Snake River valley and its tributaries; Montana, the Missouri River valley and its tributaries; Colorado, the land subject to irrigation from the South Platte and its tributaries; Oregon, the Columbia River valley east of the Cascade mountains and the valleys of the tributaries; Washington, the system of reservoirs along the east base of the Cascade mountains and investigation of the subterranean water supply in the lands requiring irrigation; Wyoming, to determine the irrigable lands in the valley of the North Platte and its tributaries; North Dakota, the arid lands between Grand Forks and Devils Lake and the arid lands between the Missouri and the upper Missouri and its tributaries; South Dakota, to construct dunes for distribution of the water of North and South Dakota rivers and tributaries; Utah, D. and Utah, the arid lands between the Colorado and the upper Colorado and its tributaries; New Mexico, Rio Grande and Pecos rivers and tributaries.
