FIRST PEACE FORUM NAMED FOR ST. LOUIS

National War Labor Board Plans Settlement of Industrial Disputes.

The first "forum of industrial peace" in the United States during the war was created by the National War Labor Board yesterday.

Members of the board declared the creation of this medium of composing differences between capital and labor marked a most important step toward the maintenance of industrial harmony while the country is involved in the worldwide struggle.

Ample Federal Authority. Possessing ample Federal authority, the St. Louis committee will endeavor by counsel and conciliation to intercept and settle controversies threatening to arise in any of the industries of that district.

Walsh Makes Statement. In a statement accompanying the announcement, Frank P. Walsh who holds the chairmanship of the board jointly with William H. Taft, said:

The plan will secure to the employer maximum production, and guarantee to the worker his right to organization, healthy growth of the principles of democracy as applied to industry, and the highest protection of his economic welfare.
