What's It Mean?

Sautoir: In heraldry, this word means a saltire, or St. Andrew's Cross—which is an X shape. From this came the meaning of a chain or ribbon worn about the neck and crossing in an X on the breast. In the 1920s, sautoir came to mean a

rope-like, open-end necklace to be draped to suit the wearer's fancy and this year the sautoir is back, heavily indored by Paris for the coming season. These will be worn in vivid combinations of colors: a typical necklace combines various shaped beads in clear crystal, topaz, coral with rhinestones. At each end are elaborate chandelier tassels suspended from chains.
