Scores Are Stricken: Woman Victim Found in Subway Clutching Bottle as Old Year Ends

### Many Revelers Are Sent to Hospitals

Seven Die in Chicago. Two in Minneapolis. One in Ann Arbor From Liquor

Two more deaths from poison liquor, due to the reckless celebration of New Year's Eve in this city, brought the total of holiday deaths from wood alcohol up to twenty-five yesterday.

Revelers were taken to hospitals, offering from alcoholism or requiring treatment by ambulance surgeons. The condition of some of the patients is critical.

Plagues were prevalent throughout the city, the combats in many instances inspired by beetle bores. Six raids were made by the 155th aviation enforcement agents who set out to drive up New Year's revelers, and some of them were ready to admit repletion that the task set them twenty-four hours before was a hopeless one as well as a thankless one.
