German Question Unchanged. FIVE-TWENTIES TO 70K.

PANAMA POINT, May 6.—The steamer Peruvia, from Liverpool on the 26th, via London, arrived on the 27th of April, at this point this morning.

Neither the steamer City of Washington nor the Propoitis, both overdue at Liverpool, had arrived up to the time of sailing of the Peruvia.

VERY LATE BY TELEGRAPH TO LONDON.—London, April 27.—The latest advices received from Germany state that Prussia objects to disrupting her forces, while Austria continues to maintain her armaments on the Italian frontier.

LIVERPOOL, April 26.—The market opened buoyant, with an advance of 1 penny, and closed heavy, with improvement, partly on the spot.

London, April 27.—Consols closed at 107 3/4 for money, five-twenties 70 3/4.

The United States steamer Kearsarge arrived at Liverpool from New York, on the 26th.

The Kearsarge is kept in strict quarantine. The New York correspondent of the London Times asserts, on the highest authority, that the United States Government will do what is right the moment the Fenians give sufficient cause for it to interfere.

The local authorities at various English ports have received Government instructions to take the proper precautions against the cholera.

The political interest in England centres in the fate of the reform bill. A division, or vote, is expected on the morning of the 26th.

Owing to a defection from the liberal ranks by the unseating of several members, because of their election by fraud, the estimates of the ministerial majority have dwindled into unity, while the opposition journals assert that there will be an actual majority against the bill.

The *Oxid* says that in the case of an absolute defeat, the ministry will immediately resign. If they have a small majority only, some of the ministers will retire, while others will insist on forming a coalition with the minority in conjunction with Lord Stanley, Mr. Walpole, Mr. Henry and others.

The London *Star* speaks for the dissolution of Parliament, and an appeal to the country in case the ministry are defeated.

Austrian and Prussian private telegrams to the Paris *Monitor* assert that pacific arrangements have been effected between Austria and Prussia, the latter power assenting to the Austrian proposal for a neutral disarmament.

The *Gazette*, of Bavaria, confirms this intelligence, asserting that all danger of a war in Germany is removed, and that Paris *Constitutionnel* accepts the news as substantially correct.

A Berlin telegram says the reports of a treaty of alliance between Prussia and Italy are absolutely unfounded.

The Massachusetts Bourneites. Boston, May 6.—In the House of Representatives this afternoon the bill to equalize the bounties of the Massachusetts soldiers was passed to be engrossed by 110 yeas to 88 nays.

The speaker ruled that the members of the House who had served in the army as soldiers, and would be entitled to receive bounties if the bill became a law, would not be permitted to vote, and he gave a very lengthy opinion in support of his ruling.

After a long debate, the rule was sustained by a vote of 120 to 65, when the larger portion of those members who would be benefited by the bill peculiarly disclaimed any intention to receive any of the money that might be due them under the provisions of the bill, and this being entered on the journal they will be allowed to vote on it.

Fire at St. Louis and St. Joseph. St. Louis, May 5.—The extensive stables and carriage-houses belonging to the Fifteenth Street Railroad Company, in the lower part of the city, together with a hundred and forty horses and mules, sixteen cars, and all the harness and forage, were burned last night. The loss is \$45,000.
