# **Senate Group** OK's Aid Bill

The administration's \$3.4 billion foreign aid program for next year has cleared its first hurdle in Congress without ma-

terial change. The Senate Foreign Relations Committee approved the bill late yesterday, 13 to 2 and the Senate is expected to pass it next week. Senators Morse, Democrat of Oregon, and Langer, Republican of North Dakota, cast the opposition yeters. sition votes.

Correction, Not Reduction

Although the total as reported is \$122 million under the Presi-dent's request, Chairman George explained the change is a correction and not a reduction in the size of the program. He said the committee found an unex-pended balance was available for one item for which new money had been requested.

Of the total in this year's bill \$1.7 billion is direct military aid and another \$1 billion is for de-fense support. The remainder is for various economic programs to strengthen areas in all parts of the world that are still out-side of the Iron Curtain.


