



Watkins Trial Continues Here

The Federal Court trial of John T. Watkins, labor union organizer, charged with refusing to tell a congressional subcommittee facts about persons who bolted the Communist Party, continued today before Judge Joseph C. McGarrachy

Watkins, a CIO United Auto
Workers official of Rock Island,
Ill., is being tried on a sevencount indictment for refusing to answer pertinent questions be-fore a House Un-American ac-tivities subcommittee in April,

During committee hearings, Watkins testified he had never

Watkins testified he had never been a Communist Party member but that he had been very close to the party. He said that he would testify regarding his own relations with the party and with regard to present party members he may know.

However, he took the position the committee had no right to attempt to force him to testify about persons who have left the Communist Party. He declared it is not relevant to the work of the committee to try to expose such persons. such persons.

Yesterday in the United States
District Court for the District
of Columbia, Assistant United
States Attorney William Hitz
rested the Government's contempt case against Watkins, after Robert L. Kunzig, formerly counsel for the Un-American Activities Committee, finished testifying against Wat-

Watkins' side of the case was to be argued today by Defense Attorney Sidney Sachs.




