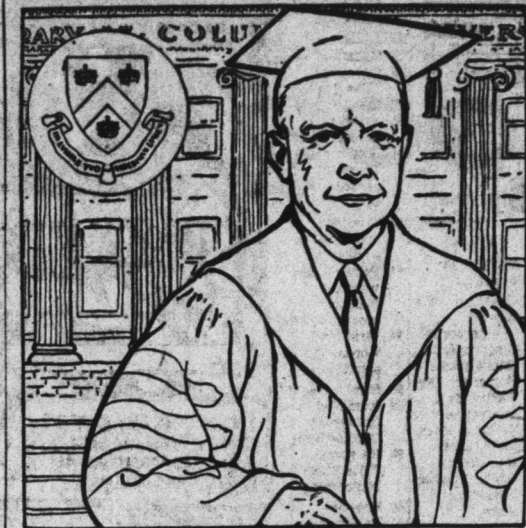

### MEET YOUR PRESIDENT—J College President

At the end of World War II Eisenhower was named Chief of Staff. For three years he directed American troops spread over four continents, and helped send them home. This work completed, he resigned in 1948 to become president of Columbia University in New York City. But his country still had work for him to do.

In 1949 Ike was called to Washington to act as special military adviser to James Forrestal, the first Secretary of Defense under the unification plan. This marked the first of several leaves Eisenhower took from his post as college president to serve his country.

The most important job was his assignment by President Truman to command supreme Army headquarters in Europe for the new North Atlantic Treaty Organization. Ike immediately flew to Paris to supervise the defense of Europe again—this time against communism.

Color the picture as you like. Remember that the robe worn by President Eisenhower is a deep purple. The emblem is the official seal of Columbia University.

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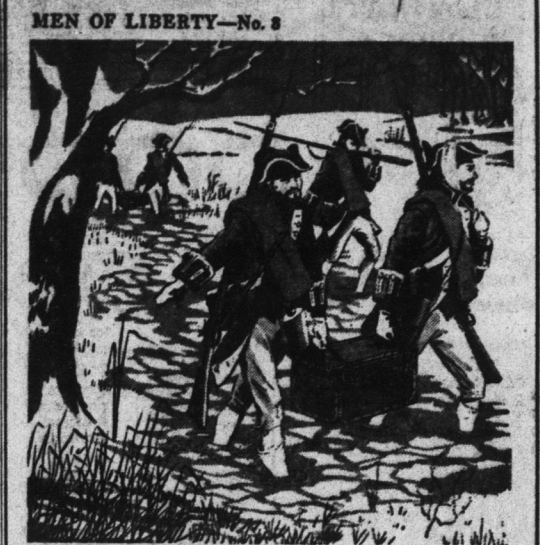
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
