At the end of World War II Eisenhower was named Chief of Staff. For three years he directed American troops spread over four continents, and helped send them home. This work completed, he resigned in 1948 to become president of Columbia University in New York City. But his country still had work for him to do.





In 1779, Colonel George Rogers Clark and a force of 130 men marched 250 miles through a freezing wilderness to capture the British force at Fort Vincennes. Hunting was prohibited lest a shot give away their silent advance. The British Garrison only realized the Americans were near when one of their men was felled by a musket ball fired through a gun port. For 24 hours the small American force poured a murderously accurate fire into the British position. Facing annihilation, the enemy surrendered and Vincennes was in American hands.
