THE APPOINTMENT TO CABINET-SHIPS.

The question will be naturally asked by the friends of reform, what does Congress propose to do to prevent its members from harboring away appointments to the Military and Naval academies? That a radical reform is absolutely necessary is evident from the recent investigations, and the promptness with which the guilty members have evaded or attempted to evade the just censure of the House.

It is popular to accuse men in high places of corruption, of barring away their privileges for gain. It costs something to run for an elective office and more to continue in office. The report of the Military Committee of the House shows that the cadetships sold were without exception disposed of for political reasons.

Although their labors are not finished, already three members have resigned, and there are several who will doubtless follow their example or be expelled. Is it expected this will check like abuses hereafter? Poplar indignation is perhaps reborn now, but how long will it last? What good, then, is anticipated more than a present purging of the guilty members.

It is true, candidates for West Point or Annapolis are bound to pass a satisfactory examination before they can be admitted to these schools. That prevents the country from being imposed upon; but why make so much of it? Congress ought not to let the hand of some legislation that will take the most important power from the people out of the mire of politics. Some of the nominations have been notoriously, for years, matter of bargain and sale. For twelve years, at least, they have been offered to the public at New York and elsewhere; and that they were sold at such a loss to the nation, and before his resistless logic, we have seen him, in short, in public and in private, as a husband, father and friend; as a statesman, patriot, and martyr, and every time we look at this new picture, the impression deepens that it is the historic portrait of him.

We have heard his simplicity of statement, his clear put forth the efforts of his clear understanding, his rare condensation of thought, and behind the shreds of sophistry before his resistless logic. We have seen him and his son, having long since dissolved their connection with that theater.
