

Norway Appalled By German Plot To Destroy Ships

Trunk of Bombs Taken In Under Seal of Berlin Foreign Office

Fountain Pens Loaded

Conspirators Admit That Vessels Bound to America Were To Be Sent Down

Christiania, Norway, June 26.—Discovery of the German plot to destroy Norwegian steamers by explosives, unearched late last week, has appalled the nation.

In all a ton of explosives has been discovered, concealed in artificial lumps of coal, which presumably were to be placed in ships' bunkers and in bombs fitted with the most ingenious mechanism.

It has developed that a trunkful of explosives was brought to Christiania in February by a courier of the German Foreign Office, whose official seal was on the trunk.
