ANOTHER NAVAL CRAFT ARRIVES

FUEL SHIP BRUTUS, EN ROUTE FROM VERA CRUZ TO PHILADELPHIA, PUTS INTO PORT AND ANCHORS AT NAVY YARD.

En route to Philadelphia via New Orleans and Pensacola, the navy fuel ship Brutus put into this port yesterday morning, taking anchorage at the navy yard, where she will remain a few days. It is possible that the Prairie and San Francisco will be supplied with coal from the Brutus, although this was not determined yesterday. The Brutus is not an American-built vessel, but, rather, was constructed in an English shipyard, and was purchased some years ago by the navy department. She was formerly the Norwegian steamer Peter Tebbsen. In charge of Captain James D. Smith, and with merchant complement, the Brutus is in what is termed either in special or unassigned service, and now returns to the states after a lengthy stay off the coast of Mexico.
