There could be no real objection to a flat 25 per cent increase, but some of the advance, due to the increase in the minimum charge for moving cars, go to more than 500 per cent.



The cash in advance for freight to take effect July 1 has been postponed to August 1. The cash in advance does not apply to freight shipped by the United States, the states, counties, municipalities and the Red Cross, or on wood shipped for fuel.

The general public is not fully aware that making railroad freight rates is something of a job. Commodities are accepted by carriers under certain classifications. These are arbitrary. One article may have several classifications, depending upon conditions, upon how it may be packed, etc.

Florida has its state classifications for local use, but they are made to blend with interstate classifications, but now the federal authorities have stepped in and is trying to rearrange matters.
