### NO INJUNCTION IS ANTICIPATED IN BULK HEAD CASE

Speaking of the Texas Oil company  
bulkhead controversies Mayor Sanders  
yesterday declared that if the  
people who are making so much  
agitation would follow the editorial  
suggestion of yesterday's Journal, and  
come to the city hall for a business  
discussion of the matter, there is no  
doubt it could be settled to the  
satisfaction of all concerned. He  
deplored the fact of so much long  
range artillery fire over it.

Both the mayor and commissioners  
asserted that the laws of the city,  
the state and the federal government  
require the construction of a bulkhead,  
and they exhibited the volumes  
containing the statutes, the city ordinance  
dating from 1908. They contended,  
therefore, that those who ask the city  
officials to recede from their position  
ask them virtually to violate the laws,  
rather than enforce them.

In this connection no reference was  
made to the fact that other enter-  
prises granted privileges on the water  
front have not been required to  
provide such bulkheads, which is one  
of the main basis of contention on part  
of the oil company officials.

The mayor stated that figures had

been secured on the construction of  
the bulkhead indicating a cost of \$6,500,  
rather than \$14,000, as stated in some  
of the discussions of the matter. Both  
Commissioner Fou and the mayor  
averred that they had entertained no  
notion whatever of instituting injunc-  
tion proceedings, and that all talk  
of such action was wholly gratuitous.

It was stated that several citizens,  
including one of the commissioners,  
had already offered to contribute con-  
siderable sums toward the expense of  
the bulkhead, and it was believed  
that if a meeting of representative  
citizens could be had at the city hall,  
the solution of the problem could be  
quickly discovered, and the city as-  
sured this important improvement on  
the water front.

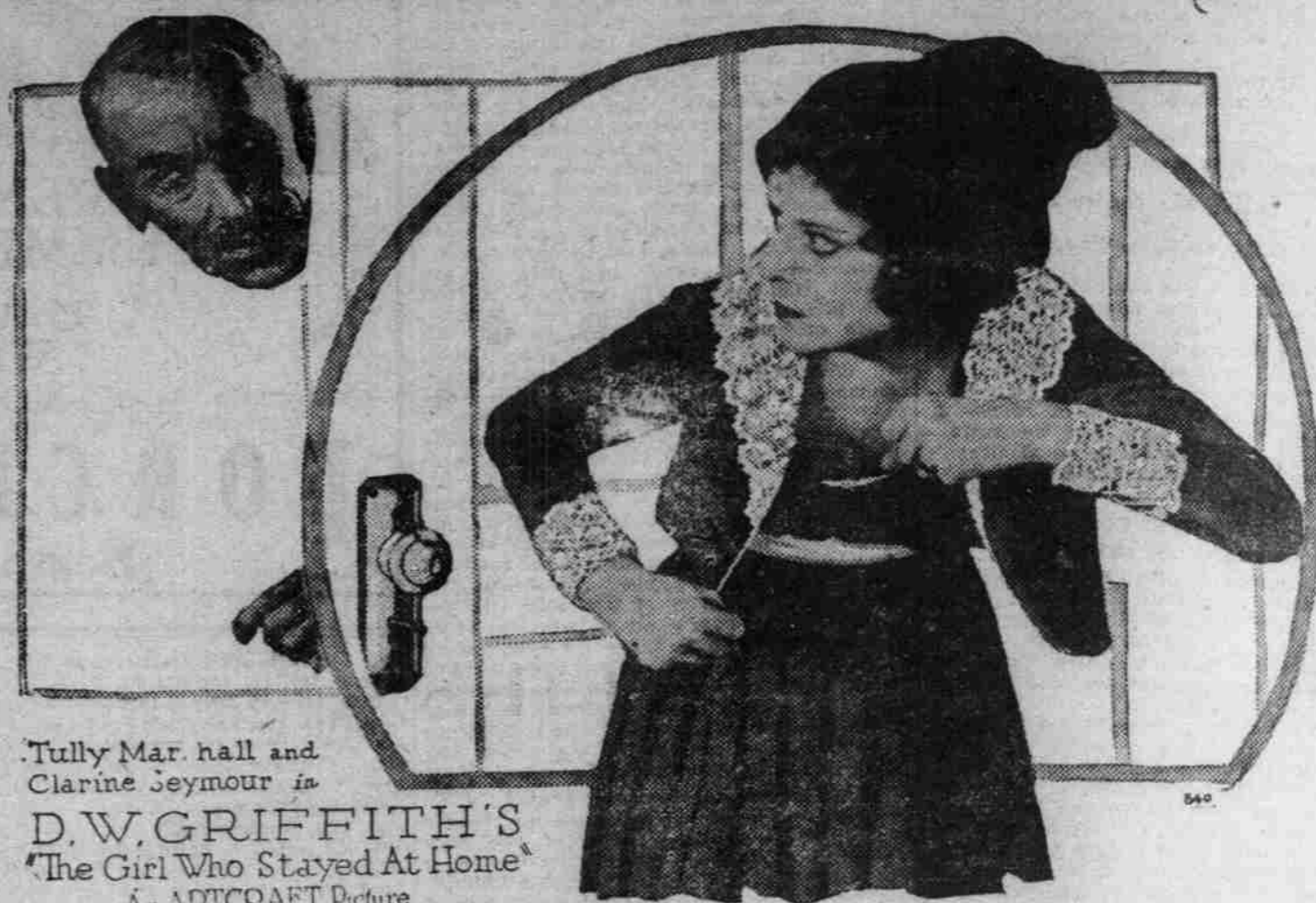
