BOLSHEVISM IS DENOUNCED BY NEGRO I. O. O. F.

Accusations made to the effect that the negroes of the south are embracing the principles of Bolshevism are most emphatically resented by the members of the Grand Lodge of Odd Fellows of the State of Florida, in session here this week. They adopted the following resolution:

"Whereas, Some unprincipled parties for the purpose of influencing the white people of the south against the negro population, have spread broadcast propaganda announcing that the colored people are embracing the principles of Bolshevism, which is a malicious slander on the colored people and the most glaring falsehood.

"Therefore be it Resolved: That the Grand Lodge of Odd Fellows, of the State of Florida, in Grand Lodge assembled, for and on behalf of the colored people, do hereby denounce the said statement as false and malicious and brand the instigators of said propaganda as enemies of the colored people and traitors to their country.

"Be it Further Resolved: That the patriotic response of our colored youth to the call of our country to join the army to make the world safe for democracy and the liberal response of the colored people of the State of Florida, who remained at home in subscribing over one million dollars to the purchase of Liberty Bonds, is a complete refutation of the slanders and is indisputable evidence of the loyalty of the colored people to our great country of which we are justly proud.

MARIANNA GETS FIRST PEACHES OF THE SEASON

YIELD IS AHEAD OF GEORGIA ORCHARDS AND QUANTITY OF FRUIT NOT TO BE SURPASSED. The first Mayflower peaches of the season were brought in yesterday by J. D. Smith, who made a small shipment from his hill orchard, about 11 miles south of Marianna. This seems to be the first commercial variety to get on the market in the southern territory. This particular high ridge which extends east and west across the southern edge of Jackson county, is attracting attention at this particular time from capitalists who are contemplating putting in many hundreds of acres of peaches and other fruits on this ridge of country. Experiments made by Mr. Smith show that the same variety grown in the peach sections of Georgia are up to this time doing well and are some earlier than Georgia orchards. Expert fruit men have passed on this section and the trees now growing to be up to any that they have seen and in many instances, better. If the yield this season is satisfactory, it is said a great acreage from northern growers.
