Wow!

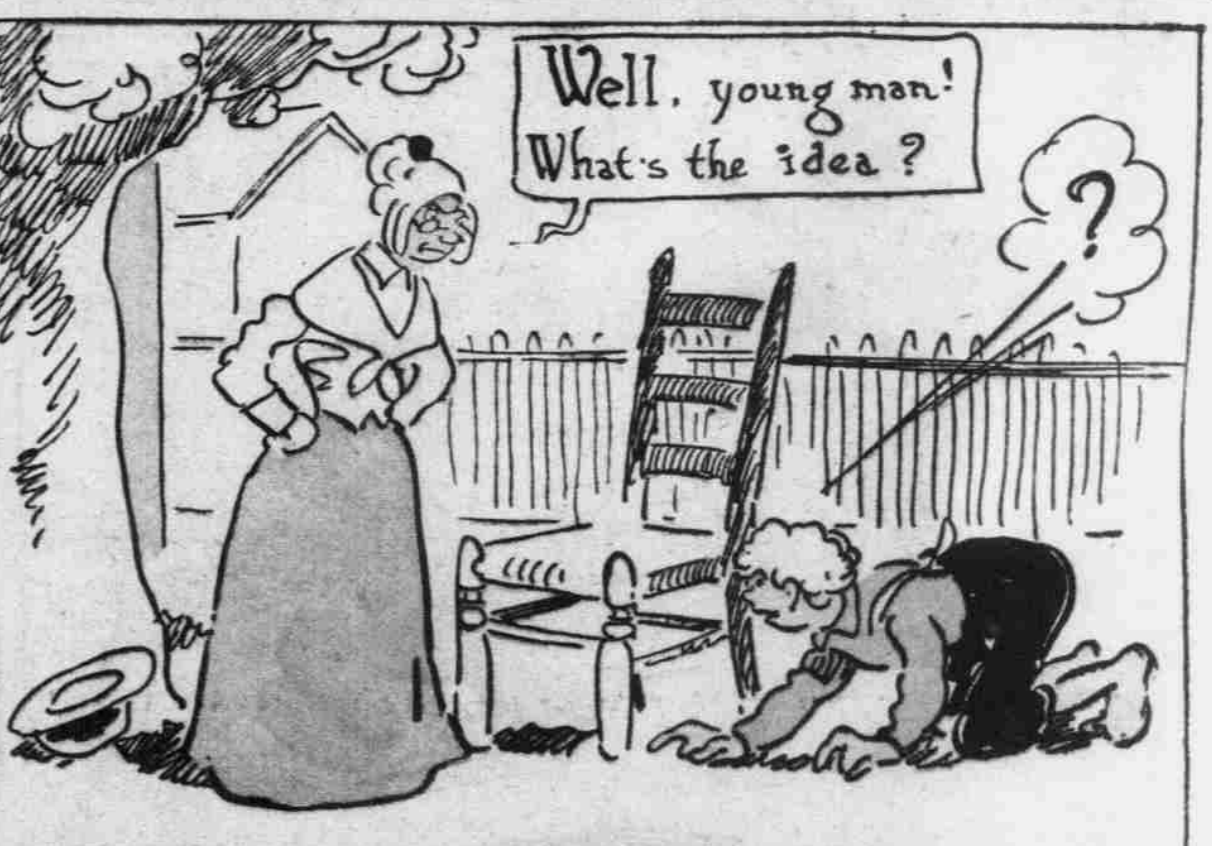


Humph! He's up to some mischief—foolin' me for some purpose.
