Trolley Situation to Be Investigated

Committee on Public Service Securities Request Appointment of Commission.

At a meeting of the committee on public service securities held in New York on April 10, 1919, after a discussion of the whole subject, the chairman was instructed to send the following letter to Roger W. Babson, of the Department of Labor.

It is common knowledge that the abnormal increases caused by the war in wages, costs of fuel and materials, and taxes, without corresponding increases in revenue, has resulted in such decreases in the net earnings of local transportation companies that they are unable to pay their operating expenses, taxes, and a fair return on the investment.

These difficulties appear to require a readjustment of the relations between the street railways, their employees, the car riders, and the public, which can hardly be accomplished piecemeal, but only by a general knowledge of all the facts and a general recognition of the principles which should govern those relations.

This committee therefore recommends the early appointment by the president of a federal board on street railway conditions, on which there would be representatives of the United States Department of Labor and other interested departments of the government.
