#### PENSACOLA DEFEATS CUSHNOCS 2 TO 1 IN BEST GAME OF YEAR

The Pensacola Regulars defeated the Cushnocs from the Pensacola Shipbuilding plant 2 to 1 at Maxent Park yesterday afternoon in one of the best games of baseball seen on a local diamond this year. The Shipbuilders lost the game in the fifth inning when Bell threw away Bonifay's short roller, Borders and Weber scoring on the play. Hartman held the Regulars to three hits while Bonifay was touched for nine, which were well scattered, however. The attendance was about 500.

The game, play by play:

First inning—Wentworth was out, Eagin to Davis. Man Matre landed on Hartman's first offering for a long foul to left and after spooling four other good balls went out, McVoy to Davis. McVoy dropped Brown's high foul. Brown then fanned. No hits, no runs, no errors.

Eagin was out on an easy grounder to Shelton. Graham's short roller was handled, Bonifay to Shelton. Grogan fanned. No hits, no runs, no errors.

Second inning—Hungerford was out, Graham to Davis. Shelton flied to Eagin. Borders fanned, Bell dropped the ball, but Borders was out, Bell to Davis. No hits, no runs, no errors.

Rouk fouled to Hungerford. McVoy singled through short and was out when Sanchez dropped Davis' infield fly, recovered it and tossed to Brown. Angelo fanned. One hit, no runs, no errors.

Third inning—Weber was out on three pitched strikes. Sanchez flied to Eagin. Bonifay struck out. No hits, no runs, no errors.

Bell fanned, but Bonifay's floater was so slow that Hungerford lost it. Bell was out, however, Hungerford to Shelton. Hartman fanned. Eagin was safe on a Texas leaguer to left center. Graham flied to Weber. One hit, no runs, no errors.

Sanchez advanced the play all round when he sacrificed, McVoy to Davis. Bell threw away Bonifay's short roller and Borders and Weber scored. Bonifay went to second, and advanced to third on a passed ball. Wentworth was out, Hartman to Davis. Van Matre fanned. Two runs, no hits, three errors.

Davis flied to Wentworth. Angelo fanned, Bell fanned. No runs, no hits, no errors.

Sixth inning—Brown was out, McVoy to Davis. Hungerford was out when Hartman took a weird roller to Davis. Shelton struck out. No runs, no hits, no errors.
