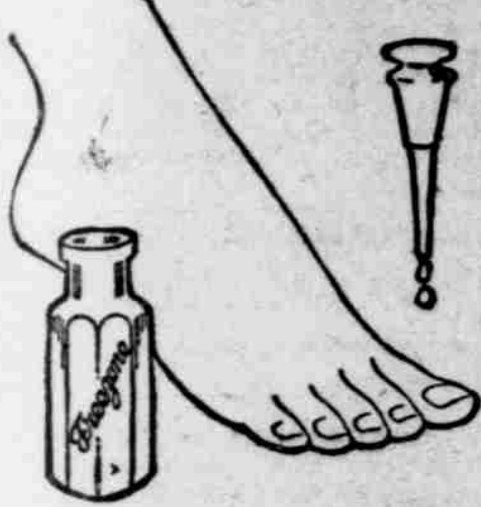

MARIANNA WILL HAVE BIG FAIR PLANS INDICATE

FLORIDA INDUSTRIAL SCHOOL EXHIBITS AT WEST FLORIDA FAIR TO BE FEATURE.

Marianna, Oct. 25.—At the Florida industrial fair, which opens at Marianna next Tuesday, October 28, and will continue through November 1, the Florida Industrial School will occupy a large and conspicuous space. The exhibit will include a complete industrial feature embracing cabinet and wood work, painting, broom work, brick made at the school, cement work, blacksmith work, shoe repairing, also agricultural and other industrial exhibits. These will demonstrate the important work of the institution.

For October 29 an invitation has been extended to every candidate for United States senator and representative in congress from this district, together with all state officers of Florida, to be present and speak. About twenty-seven have already accepted the invitation. The program for the day will be in charge of a committee composed of Hon. Amos E. Lewis, J. W. Russ, R. H. Buford and W. W. Bruce. All plans for the success of the fair have been completed and it is expected to be one of the most successful exhibitions ever held here.

SEWANEE DRIVE FOR MILLIONS IS LAGGING BADLY

CAMPAIGN FOR ENDOWMENT FUND FOR UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH WILL NOT BE COMPLETED THIS YEAR.

Chattanooga, Tenn., Oct. 25.—Bishop A. W. Knight, vice-chancellor of the University of the South at Sewanee, Tenn., and chairman of the executive committee of the million dollar endowment fund, is just back from the triennial general convention of the Episcopal church in Detroit.

Sewanee was prominently represented at the convention by alumni bishops, rectors and laymen, and on Saturday night, October 18th, Sewanee Night was observed by a banquet attended by some of the most prominent churchmen from the south. Among the speakers were Bishop Gallor of Tennessee, presiding bishop of the House of Bishops of the general convention, and Bishop William Mercer Green, of Mississippi. Immediately upon the conclusion of the convention in Detroit the Sewanee campaign in the south will be given a great stimulus by the return of their

respective fields of many interested workers among the clergy and laity. Several important speaking tours throughout the larger cities in the south will be made by Bishop Gallor and other prominent men. The campaign for Sewanee will not be completed by the first of the year, as was at first anticipated. The nation-wide campaign for funds in the Episcopal church which owns and controls the university will delay the active canvass in a number of the principal dioceses, including North Carolina, East Carolina, Missouri, Texas, West Texas, and probably others. However the campaign for Sewanee in these dioceses will begin about the first of January and the whole campaign will be completed early in the year.
