Carpenter Will Go To Pacific After Shakedown Trials

WASHINGTON, Feb. 1.—(AP).—The Navy has announced that its Pacific Fleet will have six more destroyers by September. They will be organized under the designation of "Escort Carrier One", operating from Pearl Harbor.

The Navy does not make any mention of the dispatch to the Pacific of another aircraft carrier. That move has been under consideration.

The reinforcement in the Pacific Fleet means that U. S. naval strength in the Atlantic will be reduced by one destroyer. One of the six going to the Pacific is the so-called "killer" destroyer, the Carpenter. It is the latest ship of its kind and is now undergoing shakedown trials.
