## Jones Claims He Killed Wooten Defense of Life

(By Associated Press.)  
Gainesville, Jan. 17.—The case of the State vs. Clarence Jones charged with slaying of George Wooten at his home at Fross creek, this county on January 9, 1921, is still in the hands of the jury today, having occupied the attention of circuit court all of yesterday, Judge John Edwards, of Lakeland, presiding for Judge Long, disqualified.

Two negroes were called to the stand and testified they heard the shots but did not see the shootings. S. F. Waits testified he knew Clarence Jones; saw him the night the killing occurred and that Jones told him he had killed a man and would do so again, under the same circumstances. F. W. Tyson testified he knew both parties and was a member of the coroner's jury.

Clarence Jones, the defendant, was next called. He testified he lived on Cross creek; had been living there three years and in Alachua county twenty years, going there from Dade City. He is a man with a family, he said, and all members of the family were present when the shooting occurred. He said Wooten came to his house late Sunday afternoon, January 9. He was asleep at the time and the man talked to his wife and children. Wooten started to leave at dark and Jones invited him to stay to supper, he said. He refused and jumped off the porch picking up a stick and threatened to kill the entire family and burn them up. He renewed the threat and started toward Jones, when the latter fired five times, Wooten falling near the back door.

## Palatka Is Voting day on Proposed City Manager Form

(By Associated Press.)

Palatka, Jan. 17.—Successful candidates for the office of city commissioner in today's primary face the possibility of not taking office at all merely holding the positions a few weeks because of the fact that Palatka citizens will one week hence vote on the proposal to establish a manager-commission form of government. Should this proposition be carried at the polls a manager and seven commissioners will take over the municipal affairs of the city to serve without pay.

Four commissioners are to be named today under the present form of government. Despite the apparent popularity of the proposed new form of administration, the commissioner's race has been a warm one. Eight candidates are seeking the four offices.

### NEW ENGLAND SPINNERS SAY BLEEDING TO DEATH

Providence, R. I., Jan. 17.—Necessity for reducing costs to meet southern competition was given today as the main reason for wage reductions announced in three cotton mills in eastern Connecticut. The manager of one plant which announced a 20 per cent cut effective next Monday, said that at present the northern manufacturers are slowly bleeding to death.

## SOUTH FLORIDA FAIR IS READY TO OPEN GATES

Tampa Jan. 17.—Everything is in readiness at Plant field for the opening of the South Florida fair here next month and if exhibitors were to choose to do so they could place their exhibits in the building today.

A considerable portion of the Canadian exhibit has arrived, and the manager of the Canadian exhibit and a crew of men are due here in the next few days to begin placing the showing of the dominion, which will have some six or eight times as much space as it had at the 1921 fair. E. F. White, the Canadian exhibition manager, writes that Canada's exhibit here will be second only to the showing that country made at Chicago and San Francisco, and will be of greater magnitude than any other showing made by the dominion of the continent of North America.
