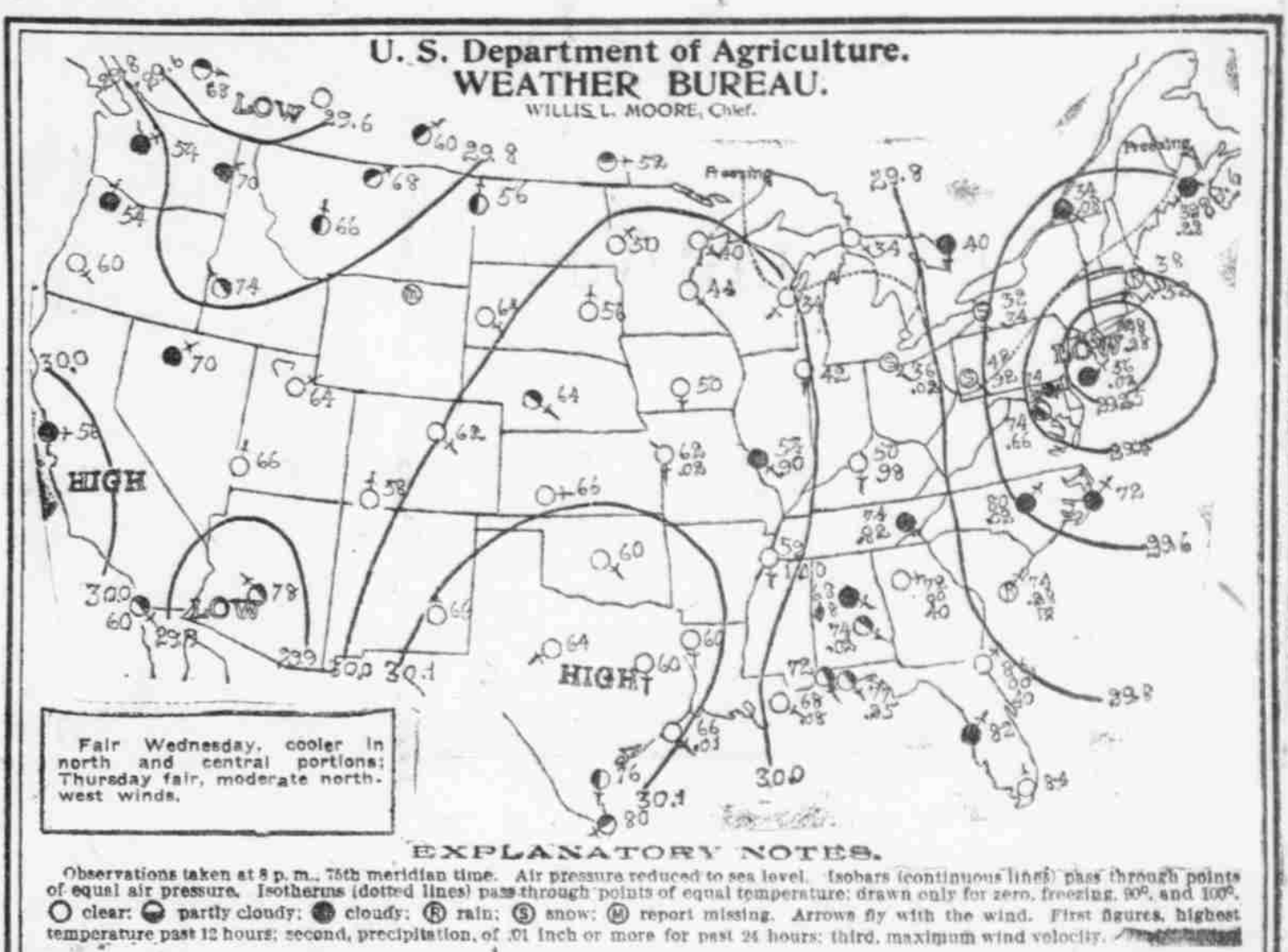

Activity of the first hour gave way to dullness with the approach of midday, when practically all of the earlier rise was lost. Before this, however, Reading, Union Pacific and Amalgamated Copper had established new records for the movement.

The decline was soon checked by covering however and the market during the afternoon with prices ruling at the lowest on reports of floods.

A more favorable weather forecast and London despatches indicating the vote of miners was turning out less favorably than expected, checked buying later in the afternoon.

Cotton futures closed quiet, unchanged; middling uplands, 10.85; middling, gulf, 11.18; sales 225 bales.

New Orleans Futures. New Orleans, April 2.—Cotton futures opened steady at a decline of 1/2 points. Cables were indifferent.
