MANUFACTURES IN PENSACOLA

CENSUS BUREAU'S TENTATIVE SUMMARY OF INDUSTRIES IN THIS CITY, CAPITAL INVESTED AND NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES.

Special to the Journal. Washington, D. C., April 5.—A preliminary statement of the general results of the census of manufactures of the city of Pensacola, Florida, for the year 1909, was issued today by Census Director Durand.

The figures are preliminary and subject to such revision as may be necessary after a further examination of the original reports. The summary shows increases of 54 per cent in the number of establishments; 16 per cent in the cost of materials used; 2 per cent in the number of salaried officials and clerks; 1 per cent in capital invested; and 1 per cent in the value of products.

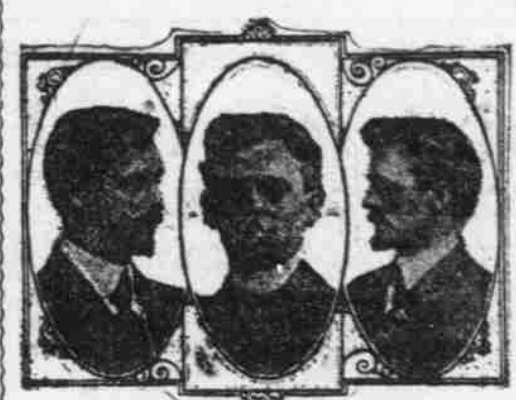

COLORADO SPRINGS REVERSES ITS ATTITUDE ON PROHIBITION. By Associated Press. Colorado Springs, Colo., April 5.—Principally for the benefit of the tourist who desires to quench his thirst in something stronger than ice water after a day spent in sight-seeing, Colorado Springs yesterday reversed its attitude on prohibition and by a majority of 932 out of a total vote of 9,513 decided upon a plan of restricted liquor selling which permits hotels of 75 rooms or more to serve their guests and allows drug stores to handle bottled goods.
